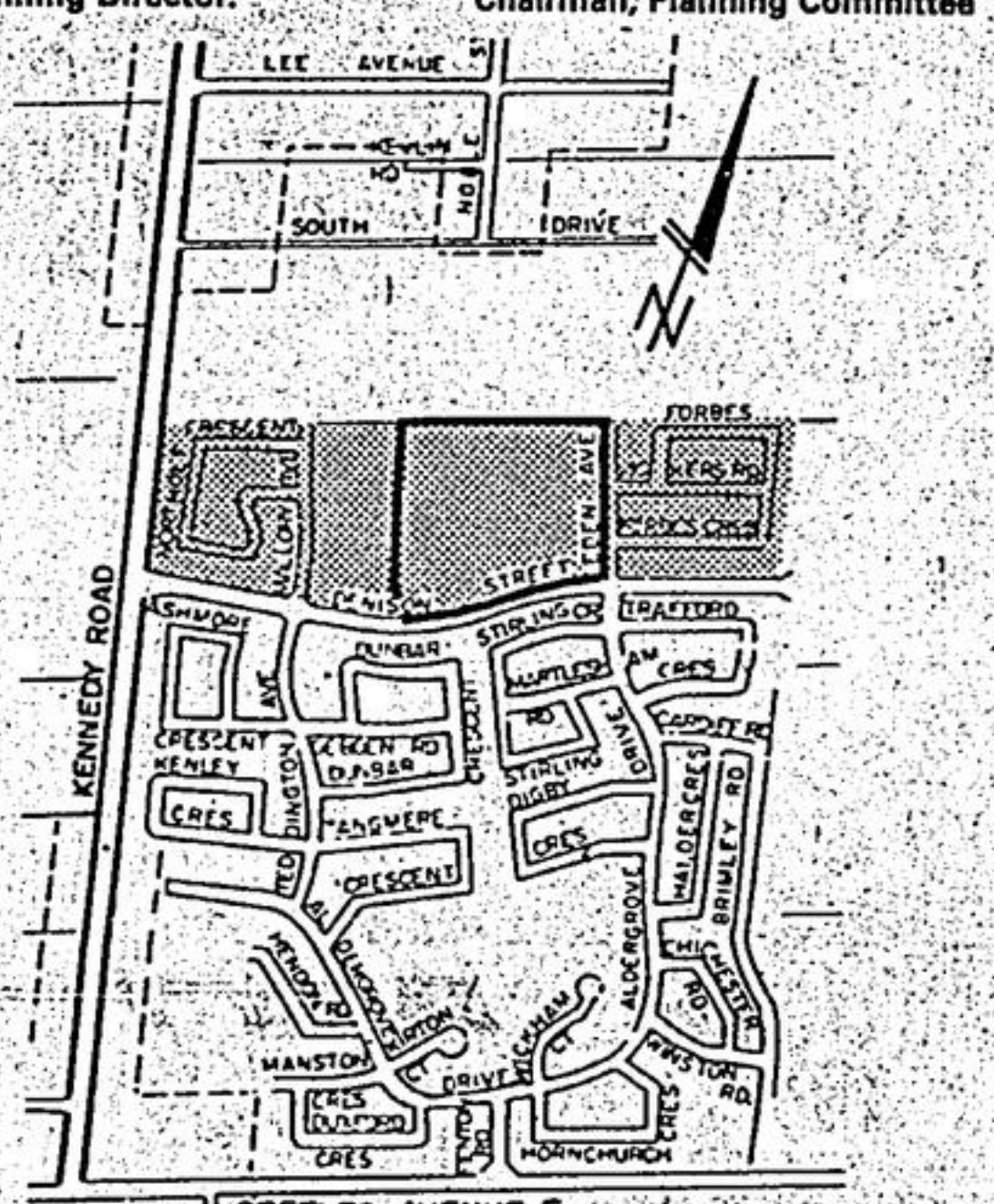

# MARKHAM PUBLIC MEETING

**TUESDAY, JANUARY 3, 1984, 7:30 P.M.**  
**COUNCIL CHAMBERS, MUNICIPAL OFFICES, BUTTONTVILLE, ONTARIO**  
**8911 Woodbine Avenue, Markham, Ontario.**  
 A Public Meeting will be held by the Planning Committee of the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Markham to consider a proposed amendment to the Secondary Plan (PD-2) for Part of the Risebrough Planning District and a proposed zoning by-law amendment to be enacted under the authority of Section 34 of the Planning Act.  
 The lands subject to the proposed secondary plan amendment consist of Lots 26 to 104 and Blocks 144 and 146, R.P. 65M-2095 and Lots 1 to 101 and Blocks 154 to 157 and 161 to 163, R.P. 65M-2096 and are located on the north side of Denison Street and the east side of Kennedy Road. The subject lands are shown on the map below.  
 The proposed secondary plan amendment would increase the density for the subject lands from 45 persons per hectare (118 persons per acre) to 48.8 persons per hectare (19.75 persons per acre), and increase the maximum number of units from 12.35 units per hectare (5 units per acre) to 13.55 units per hectare (5.5 units per acre).  
 The lands subject to the proposed zoning by-law amendment consist of Part of Block 146, R.P. 65M-2095 and Blocks 154 to 157, R.P. 65M-2096 and are located on the north side of Denison Street approximately 365 metres east of Kennedy Road as shown on the map below.  
 The proposed zoning by-law will rezone the subject lands from Institutional and Open Space (O2) to Single Family Residential Sixth Density (R6).  
 The effect of the proposed secondary plan amendment and zoning by-law amendment will be to permit a residential plan of subdivision on the lands located between Mallory Avenue and Eden Avenue on the north side of Denison Street with 117 single family lots. The purpose of this meeting is to ensure that adequate information is made available to the public and to afford any person the opportunity to make representations in respect of the proposed secondary plan amendment and zoning by-law amendment. If you are unable to attend the meeting, your representation can be filed in writing either by mail or personal delivery to reach the office of the Planning Director not later than January 3, 1984.  
 The proposed secondary plan amendment and zoning by-law amendment and additional information relating thereto is available for inspection in the Planning Department, second floor, 8911 Woodbine Avenue between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., Monday to Friday, or further information may be obtained by telephoning the Planning Department at 477-7000, extension 224 during the same hours.
