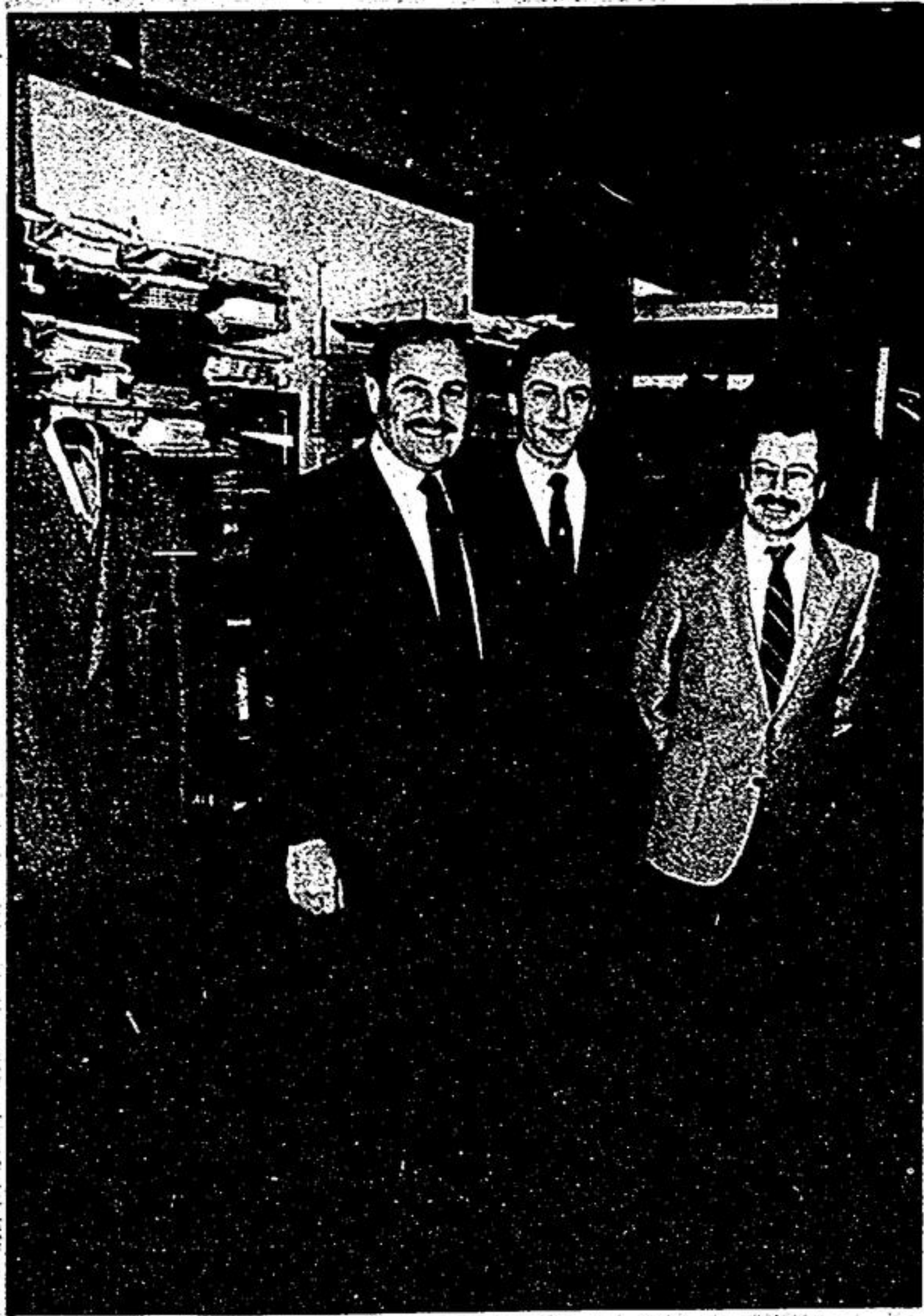


# REFLECTIONS OF MARKHAM

Unionville's only kitchen shop with a selection of gourmet gadgets, cookbooks, Danish stainless as well as "country seamer" chairpads and table linens.

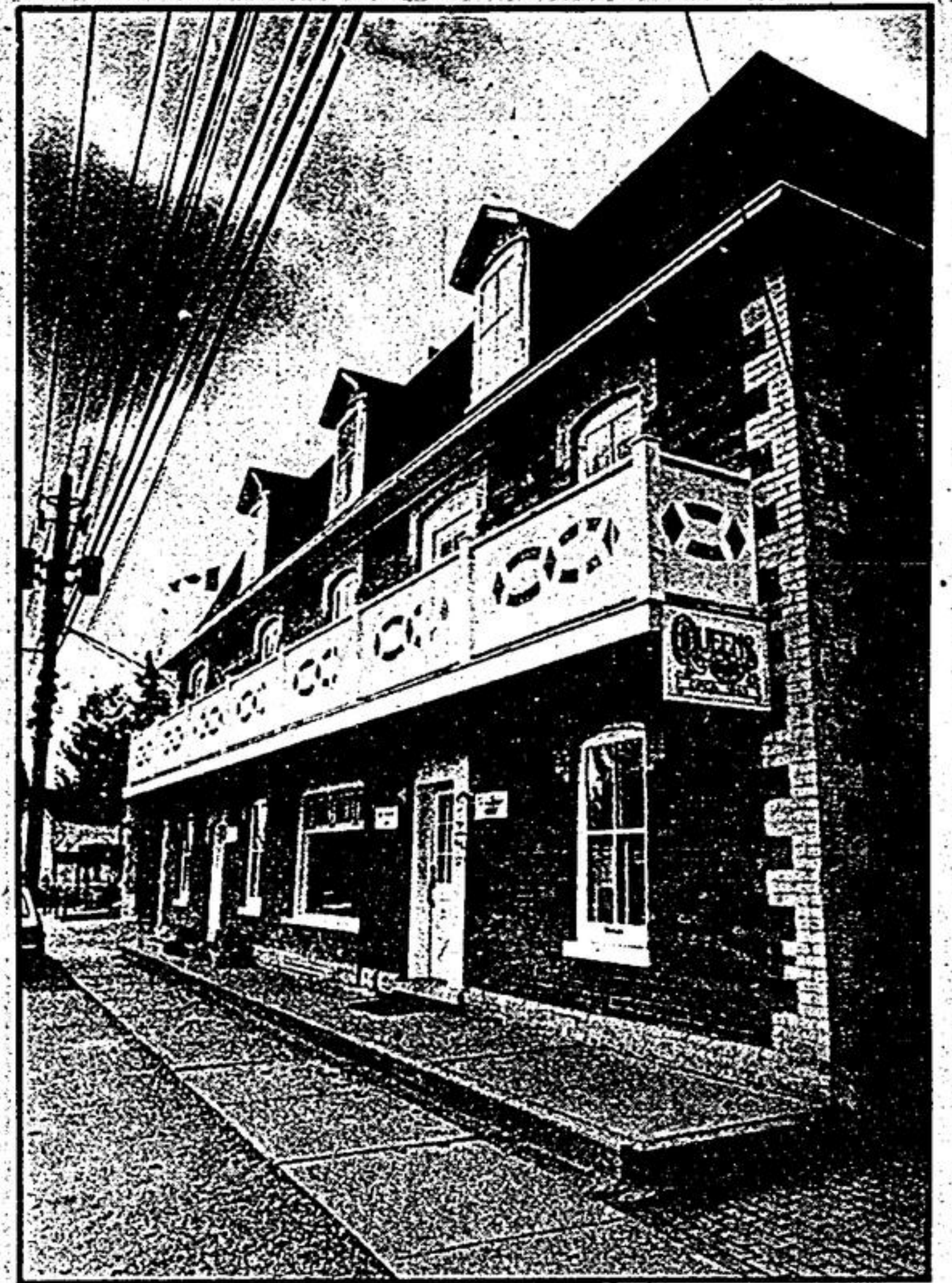
## UNIONVILLE CRAFTY GALLERY - 475-0069
