

Was respected area farmer

VICTORIA SQUARE — Service was held from Victoria Square United Church, Thursday, for Cecil G. Nichols; one of this area's best known and most highly respected residents.

Mr Nichols passed away, Jan. 2. He was 75.

Born at Victoria Square, the son of Louis and Harriet (Wellman) Nichols, he farmed in the community until his retirement to Elm Road, Stouffville, six years ago.

Mr and Mrs Nichols were married Nov. 24, 1934. They would have celebrated their Golden Wedding Anniversary this year.

Mr Nichols' involvement in the life of the Victoria Square community gained him much respect. He was extremely active in the work of the church where he held several positions of responsibility. As a young man, he was also involved in Jr. Farmers. He later served as a director on the executive of the Stouffville Co-operative.

Mr Nichols had not enjoyed good health for the past two years. He was released from York Central Hospital, Richmond Hill, last month, so he could be home for Christmas.

Besides his wife, the former Florence Baker, he is survived by three sons, Frank

in Pennsylvania; Donald of Stroud; Allan at R.R. 1, Gormley; three daughters, Lillian (Mrs Desmond Meed), St. John, New Brunswick; Marion (Mrs Nelson Buchanan), Willowdale; Faye (Mrs Donald Hamilton), Newmarket; two sisters, Reva (Mrs Douglas Gee) of Richmond Hill; Vera Nichols in Toronto and eighteen grandchildren.

Rev. Katherine Irwin and Rev. Martin Jenkinson shared the funeral service, Thursday afternoon, with interment, Victoria Square Cemetery. The sanctuary was filled to capacity. Pall-bearers were six grandchildren—David Meed, Brian Nichols, Kevin Nichols, Donald Nichols, Vincent Hamilton and James Buchanan.

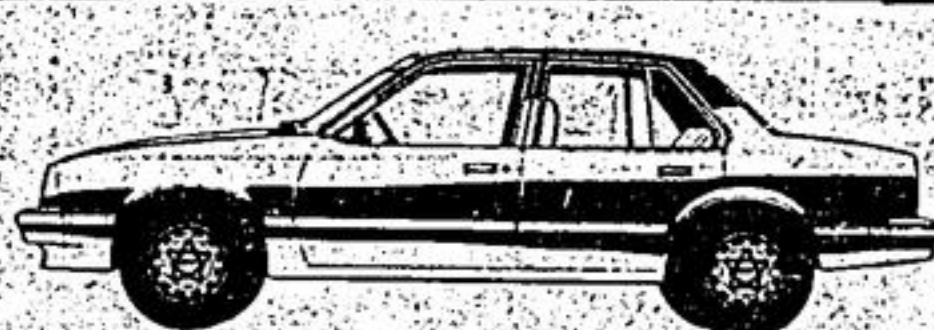

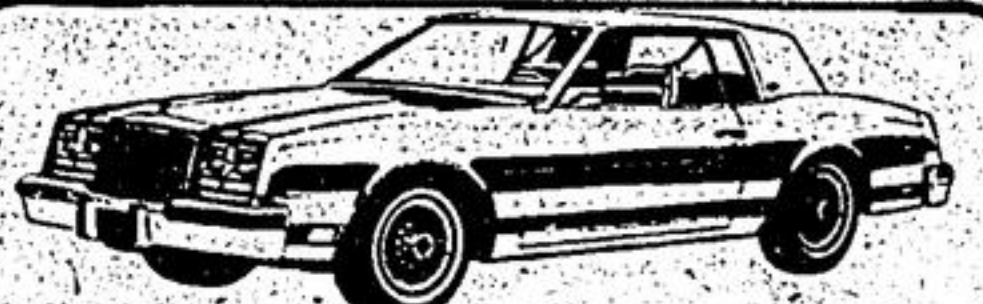
