Work may freeze

UXBRIDGE — Extreme cold weather conditions have caused Vantage Building Corporation to halt the construction of Uxbridge's new central works depot, at Regional Road 8, Lot 30 Conc. 5 said Uxbridge Works and

Roads Chairman, Don Jackson. "They don't want to proceed," said Jackson, during a phone interview. "It's costing them extra money."

During last Thursday's Works and Roads Com-

mittee meeting members discussed how cold temperatures were making construction of the 18-foot high, 13,200 square foot depot almost impossible.

"They're not really doing any-

thing," said Assistant Road Supervisor, Darrel Horne.

Construction on the \$254,000 depot started recently, but the general suggestion at the meeting was to stop work and continue in the spring

when weather conditions improved.

However, Jackson told the Tribune, before any final decisions were made a meeting would have to be set up between the committee and Vantage Building Corporation.
