Slow down urbanization

Dear Sir,

In reference to your front page story of Feb. 15 under the heading "Approve Estate Lots" I wish to make comment as one of the residents who "wasted his time" according to Councillor Morley, and who raised some "ridiculous arguments" in Councillor Rae's opinion.

The Council and the Tribunal all have clearly missed the point of the Green Koru petition and the objections Mr. Wade's development was only the focal point of the much broader concerns of residents. (R.R. 22 Newmarket for your information) is a postal address, much of which is on the 7th Concession and the St. John Sideroad and within the boundaries of Whitechurch-Stouffville. We are seeing spot development springing up here and everywhere, approval for line additional lots, to the recently approved 21, two hundred plus lots pending for the Aurora Sideroad — it goes on and on.

And who speaks in favor? Why real estate agents, brokers, developers and businessmen motivated by financial gain and in opposition to residents who have only the best interests of the region as their aim?

Surely we can slow down this head-long plunge toward total urbanization long enough to collect all the data and develop a plan, so we make a mistake that can't be recalled when the pro-support is based on benefits to the Town. Revenue, residential dormitory development never pays its own way. The added cost of services to these spot developments soon outpaces revenues from building permits and property taxes, leaving the increased burden to be shared by all.

I'm afraid Mr. Editor, that the old bug-a-boos will continue to haunt us and it seems to me they are very relevant to the point of this discussion. Only a fool or a madman would drink from a well within one mile of a potential chemical catastrophe until all the evidence is in. What is the rush? All we asked for is time to consider the matter, fully and weigh the consequences.
