To honor citizens

STOUFFVILLE — The Town of Whitechurch:

Stouffville has been given the greenlight to nominate five people for Bi-centennial Medals that will be awarded citizens who have served their community well.

"We'd be grateful to hear from anyone," said Mayor Eldred King.

The Province will award 1,984 citizens for community service and volunteerism.

Councillor Tom Wood suggested the Silver Jubilee Club should have the responsibility of naming the citizens. He explained the Club chooses a senior citizen, to honor each month, who has served the community in some form.

Mayor King said he would be pleased to receive nominations from the Club, but other community organizations and services should also be allowed to participate.

"There are many organizations that may be able to provide assistance," he said.

A written statement of what community services have been carried out by the person nominated should be submitted with each entry.

Whitechurch-Stouffville must submit nominations to the Bi-centennial Awards Committee by June 30. Presentations will take place at a fall ceremony.
