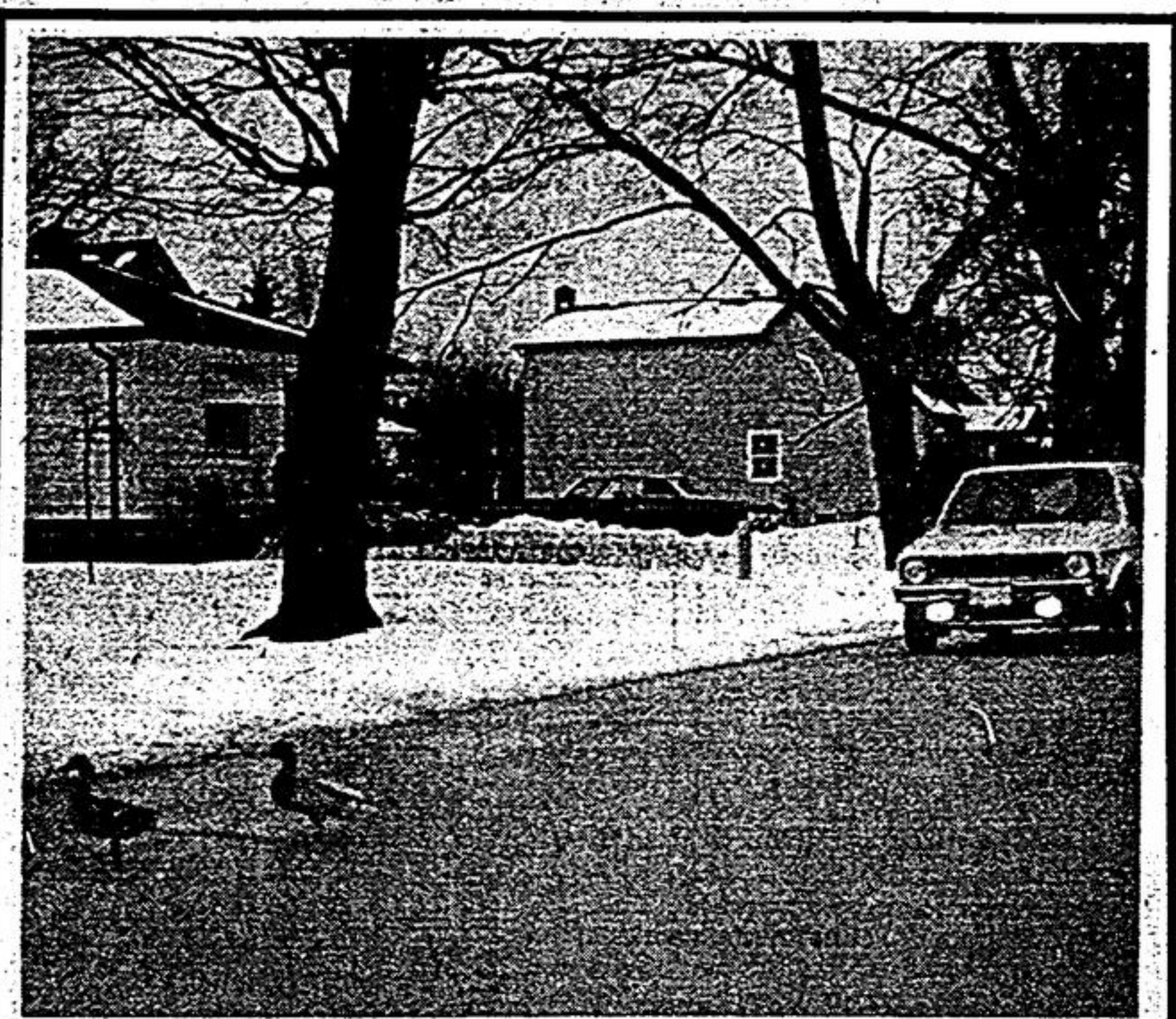
# Bike safety offered
