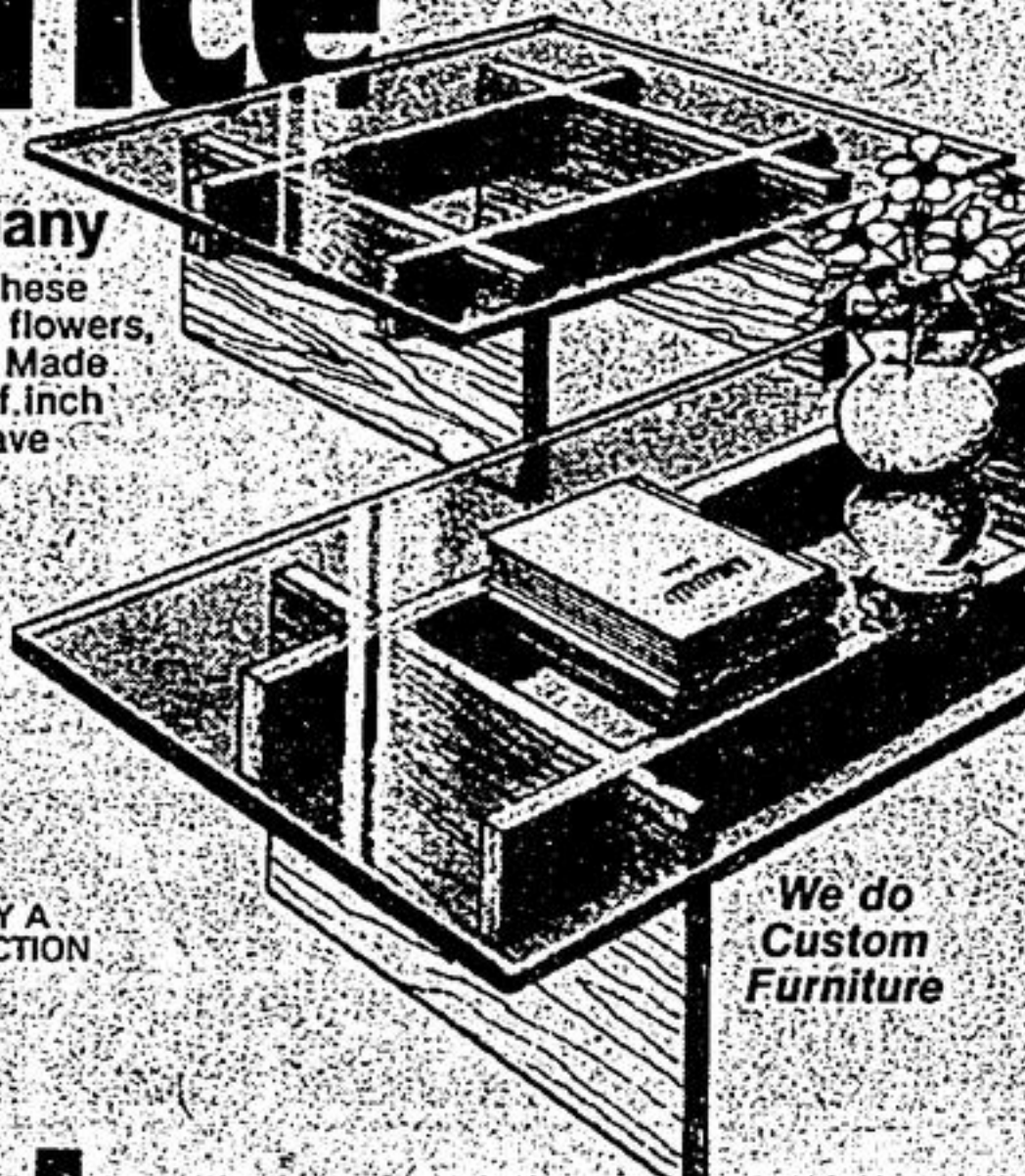

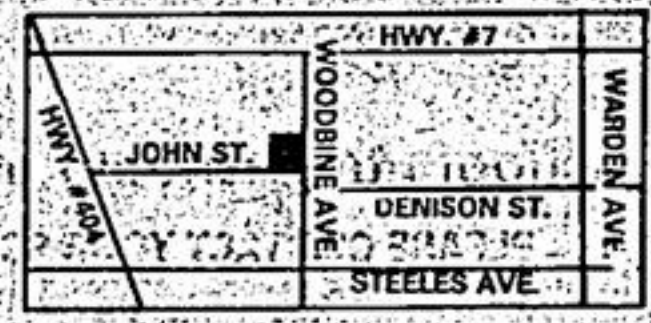

DURHAM — The Durham Board of Education is serious about emergency situations so they've supported the Durham Save-A-Heart organization in their aim to instruct staff and students in cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR).

CPR, a method of mouth-to-mouth resuscitation for victims of heart attacks, drowning, suffocation, and other emergencies, has been a growing program throughout Durham schools.

Some student council representatives have requested the board provide both optional and compulsory training at the Heart Saver (five to six hours) and Basic Rescue (12 hours) levels.
