Took advantage Drivers assaulted

A former driver examiner in Aurora has been convicted of sexual and common assault against young girls, including three from the Town of Markham.

York Regional Police arrested the Ministry of Transportation and Communications employee Nov. 16, 1983 following a three month investigation. He was charged with 16 counts of sexual and common assault.

Police were tipped off when a student from St. Robert Catholic High School came forward after a presentation on rape and sexual assault. The girl complained she had been assaulted while taking her driver's examination in Aurora.

This sparked a three month investigation by Sergeant Frederick Tufnell and Constable Rodney Sine of the York Regional Police Force.

Constable Sine told the Economist and Sun they interviewed more than 80 girls from across York Region. Two 17-year-old girls, a 16-year-old and a 21-year-old woman told police that a driver examiner had touched them on the knee, shoulders and breasts while out in their vehicles undergoing Ontario Ministry of Transport drivers tests.

On April 16 in Newmarket Provincial Court, Anthony Mellangers, 36, of Tottenham, pleaded guilty to one count of sexual assault and three counts of common assault.

He was given an 18-month suspended sentence and ordered to do 80 hours of community work. Mr. Mellangers also received a year's probation and must seek psychiatric counselling.

Upon his arrest, Mr. Mellangers was suspended from his driver examiner's duties and has since left the Ministry of Transportation and Communications. He is now working as a truck driver.
