# MP requests airport ideas

**PICKERING** - this property is presently not being used to its full potential and I would appreciate receiving your views on how you feel we can best use this area," a recent Fennell release stated.  
He plans to canvas all levels of government, as well as local residents, farmers and members of the anti-airport Peoples organization.  
"I need to know the concerns of the residents of Ontario Riding," Fennell said.  
The MP personally favors a plan which would see the property sold at reasonable rates to young farmers, with support coming from both provincial and federal governments.  
Another proposal calls for a portion of the land to be designated as "green space" for recreational purposes. Fennell feels this is an important step considering the rapid growth occurring in the area.
