'A dangerous situation'

At a meeting of Council on May 22, Councillor Jim Sanders brought attention to what he considers to be a "dangerous situation".

He was referring to the children's slide on Burkholder Street, north-west of

the pool at Stouffville Park. Sanders' concern was that children playing on the slide risk the danger of running into traffic on the nearby roadway. "Kids crossing the street could be hit by traffic," he said. Sanders proposed

moving the slide to a new and safer location.

Mayor Eldred King moved that it be relocated and the matter be referred to the recreation department.

Councillor Wilf Morley objected, calling it a

"ridiculous resolution." "That thing has been sitting there forever. Why don't we sit down and plan our parks better, instead of picking the slide up and moving it somewhere else where people will complain."
