The children of Gormley Missionary Church raised \$461.60 in support of missionary children. The total was revealed following a bank-breaking ceremony, Sunday, an all-time high.

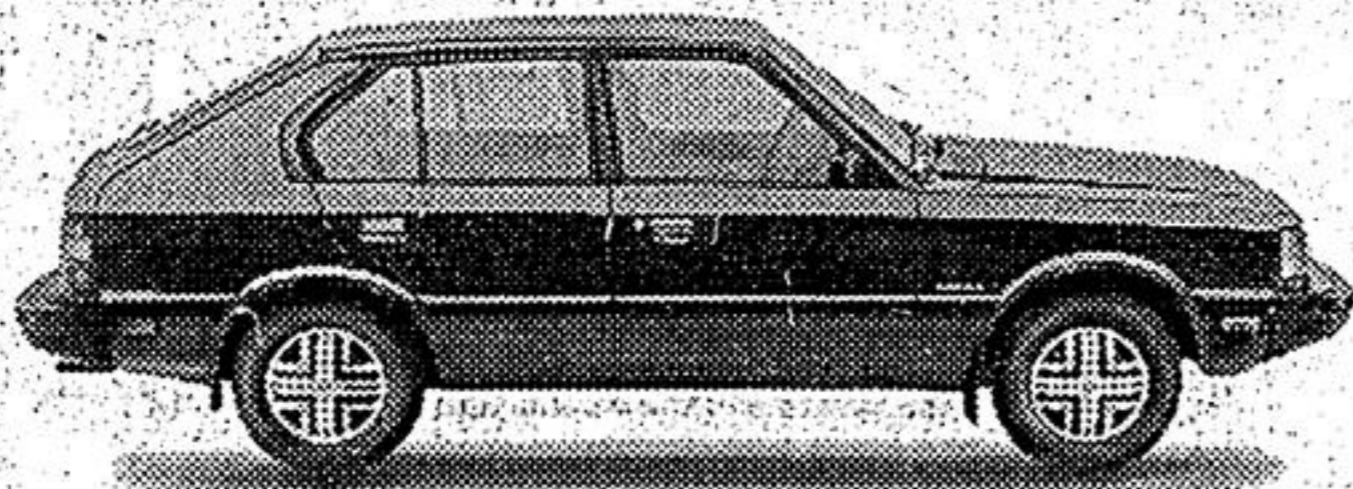
The Sr. Ladies Sewing Circle met Tuesday at the home of Adeline and Mary Reaman.

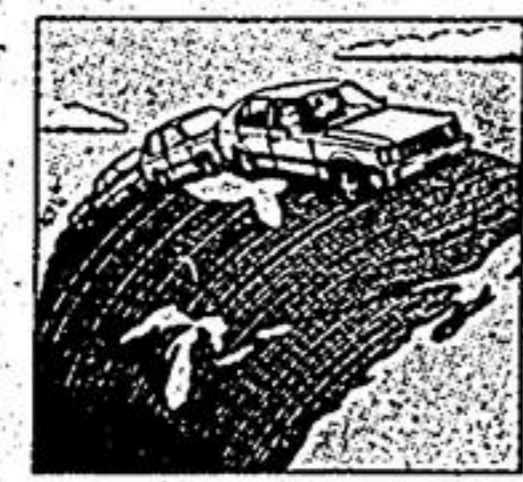
