Abortions Many alarmed

STOUFFVILLE — The number of abortions performed in hospitals across Ontario, including York and Durham Regions, is looked on with alarm by Right-To-Life organizations.

According to statistics published recently, there were 93,102 reported abortions carried out in 83 hospitals in the past three years, (1980-1982).

Because of this, silent vigils were held at various hospital locations, June 17, (Fathers' Day), a form of protest against this practice.
