### Hospital meeting is set

STOUFFVILLE — The annual meeting of the Markham York Hospital Corporation will be held on Thursday, July 26 at 7:30 p.m. at the old arena, Markham Community Centre, Hwy 7 and 48.

This corporation is the legal entity for the Markham Stouffville Hospital.

A major function of the meeting will be the election of 10 trustees to the board. The nominating committee will present 15 names, all of whom are residents of the community and have exhibited the interest and experience to contribute substantially to the board's deli-

berations. Voting is open to both annual and lifetime members of the hospital association. Annual members are those that have paid a \$5 membership by June 26, 1984.

Lifetime members are all those, including husbands and wives, who have made a donation of at least \$100 to the hospital anytime prior to June 26.

No voting by proxy will be allowed. The agenda and other material can be picked up at the hospital office, 114 Main St. N. after July 23 or at the meeting.

### 10-hour meeting sets record

STOUFFVILLE — Council meetings aren't (necessarily) controlled by the clock.

The session, July 10, was an example. Members convened at 1 p.m., adjourned at 6:02 p.m., reconvened at 7:16 p.m., and adjourned at 12:06 the following morning, undoubtedly a record.

Due possibly to the longevity of the agenda, no debate occurred when Council's 1984

salary bylaw was presented. Retroactive to Dec. 1, 1983, the mayor will receive \$13,727 plus \$3,000 car allowance. The six councillors will receive \$8,236, also retroactive to Dec. 1, 1983. One-third of this will be considered expenses.

The amount represents a five percent increase over 1983.

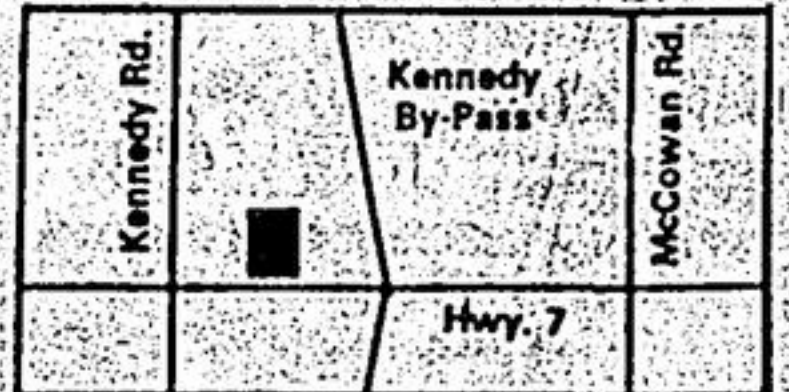
