

# Flower show 'thing of beauty'



The Stouffville Horticultural Society hosted a beautiful flower show, Aug. 22 and 23 with 365 entries. Winner of the Sue Burkholder Memorial Award for Best Basket was Della Paisley, Ninth Line South.

there were 33 exhibitors including nine in the children's class. It's the Society's 60th anniversary.

**STOUFFVILLE** — Thirty-three exhibitors, including 24 adults and nine children, placed 365 exhibits in the Stouffville Horticultural Flower Show, a response that Society president Lillian Byer described as "wonderful".

The children's display, called "a highlight of the show," honored Meghan Stouffer as top Junior Girl (under 12 years) and Glenn Painter, top Junior Boy. Laurie and Tim Pugh took top girl-boy awards in the 12 to 16 year old classes.

Other exhibitors in these categories included-Cathy Hendren, Tammy Yake, Angie Pugh and Shelley Painter.

Visitors, some who had never seen the flower show here before, were amazed at both the quantity and quality of entries. Said one: "How could I have missed such a thing of beauty all these years?"
