Late Wilf McWhinnie Displayed courage

STOUFFVILLE — For any man as active as Wilfred (Wild) McWhinnie, the loss of both legs in 1977 would have been an unbearable experience. However, Mr. McWhinnie persevered by adopting other interests and activities including outdoor gardening. He loved flowers and produced many in the basement of his Westlawn Crescent home. He also became very proficient in the operation of the family's small tractor and, with the help of son Kevin and daughter Jill, kept their place in immaculate condition.

Wilf McWhinnie died Sept. 17 in Scarborough Centenary Hospital. He suffered two heart attacks in the afternoon after being admitted there by ambulance in the morning.

Born in Toronto, the son of Hugh and Clara (Williamson) McWhinnie, he served in the R.C.A.F. during World War II and held the rank of Flying Officer.

One of his greatest ambitions was to return to the base site in York, England, a dream that was realized in 1980. He also attended an Air Force Reunion in Toronto in 1983.

Mr and Mrs McWhinnie and family

moved to Stouffville in February, 1956. At the time, there were no houses north or west of their property.

An avid sportsman, he coached baseball teams in Stouffville and served on the Town Parks Board. He was also a member of the Stouffville Lions Club.

He enjoyed his association with the Stouffville Players, a theatrical group that was prominent here through several years. Recently, he attended a reunion at the home of Frank Mellon, Cherry Street, Vivian.

He was a strong supporter of the Toronto Argonauts and Blue Jays.

Mrs. McWhinnie, the former Margaret Ribby, predeceased her husband five years ago. Surviving, besides a son and daughter, are two sisters, Ivy MacPherson of London, Ont., and Reta McWhinnie, Toronto.

Father James Adams of St. Mark's Catholic Parish, Stouffville, conducted the service from the O'Neill Funeral Home, Thursday, with interment, Stouffville Cemetery. The pall-bearers were Don Gibson, Murray Stewart, Paul Mathews, Bob Hassard, John Foulds and Frank Mellon.

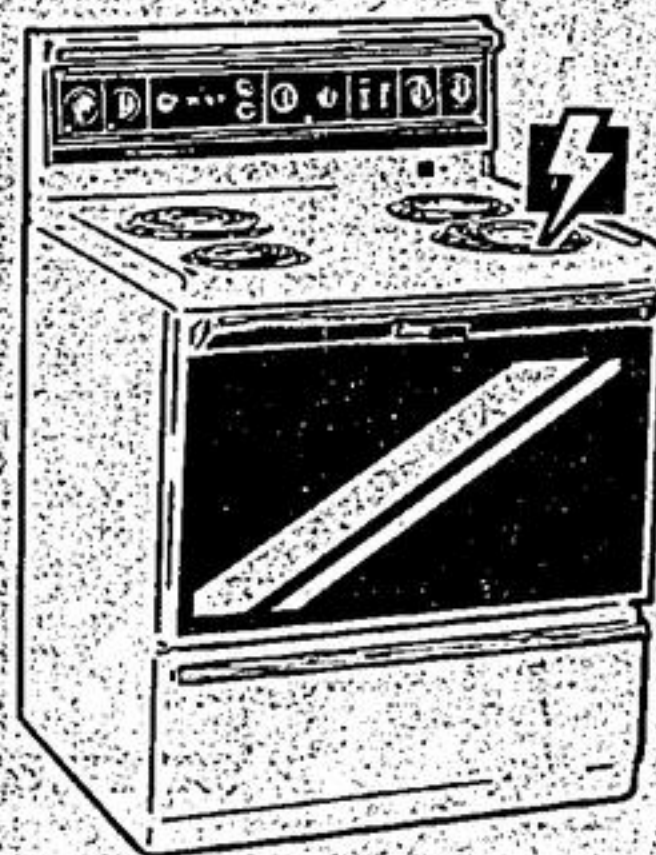

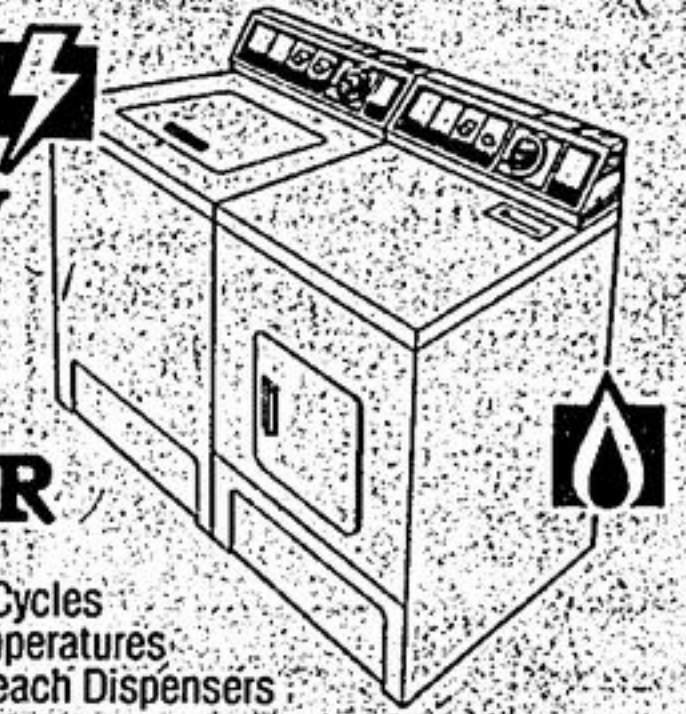

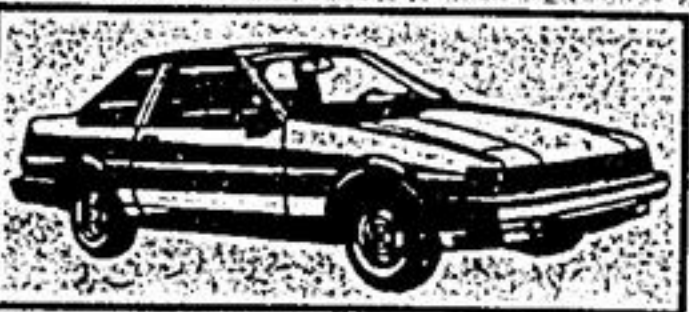
