His "shot" of Newmarket ballerina Katherine Zenna, caught the judge's eye. He also won the President's Award, a photo taken on the farm of John and Paul Grove, R.R. 2, Markham, during harvest time.

Mr Davenport's hobby is photography. He estimates the value of his equipment at \$8,000 including five cameras. He's hoping son Bryan, eight, will place entries in the Fair next year.

Ian does a lot of color photography but his preference is black and white. He describes this as "a dying art."

He participates only at Markham Fair and claims the competition is "fierce". "It's getting bigger and better," he says.

Ian carries a camera in the ambulance but never takes pictures of accident scenes. It's against department policy, he says. "Besides, I don't have time." On occasions, he'll take a shot of a fire, but nothing more.

He enjoys shooting scenes at Christmas, taking advantage of the multi-colored lights.

Is Mrs Davenport a camera buff? Ian was asked.

"She's very tolerant," Ian replied, "and my severest critic."
