Cathryn and I are celebrating our fifteenth wedding anniversary tonight. The years slip by ever so quickly but we are both grateful for our good health and happiness. Friends this evening have presented us with a gift of dinner at the new Ramada Renaissance, Whitesides restaurant. The Renaissance is located at Kennedy Road, north of the 401 highway.

On special occasions when drink will be included during the festivities, in order to protect others and have a carefree evening, we use a limousine service. Selective Cadillac Limousine, Unionville is not only reasonably priced but affords us safe and efficient transportation. The Renaissance is quite an elegant place with a beautiful indoor garden courtyard surrounding the pool area. We spend a little time leisurely exploring the hotel and then make our way to the Whitesides dining room.

I'm not involved in carpet sales but we notice the carpets are very threadbare and patched in places. This is somewhat surprising for a hotel that is only two years old. Whitesides offers a European style dining area with intimate check to check booth style tables. The glow-

ing candle and my charming companion compliment these confines wonderfully. Following our before dinner cocktail I enjoy a crusty, cheesy coated french onion soup. Cathryn loves her appetizer of smoked salmon garnished with chopped egg yolk, egg white, capers, sliced onion rings and lemon.

My main course of roast beef and Yorkshire pudding is disappointing as the meat is very fatty and the Yorkshire not up to snuff. Cathryn claims the opposite and savors her tender beef tournedos baked in pastry. This is topped with foie-gras, asparagus, tart hollandaise served with madeira sauce. Simply superb. Rose, smooth and chilled has accompanied our meal. Desert is a creamy mocha vanilla anniversary cake very tasty and meal ending. Flaming liquors and our choice of Twinings tea concludes our evening at Whitesides.

This being a special occasion, our evening would not be complete without dancing the anniversary waltz. Our driver, Len, takes us to the Monte Cristo restaurant in Stouffville where one of our favorite entertainers, Bob Davies completes our evening with song and a great sense of humour.
