### Anniversary speaker

## Challenges teens to take a stand

STOUFFVILLE — "Take a stand—dare to be different," Dr. Leonard DeWitt urged young people attending an anniversary youth service at the Stouffville Missionary Church, Friday.

Dr. DeWitt, guest speaker throughout the congregation's anniversary weekend, described the peer pressures facing young adults today as "unbelievable."

The teen years, he said, are crucial times. He said parents, in the audience, to share proper values with their sons and daughters. "If you don't, they'll obtain

them elsewhere, values you're not going to like."

Many young people, he said, turned off by the church, have nothing or no one to turn to. Often, he said, suicide is the result.

"Be more than just a statistic in a meaningless society," he urged.

Dr. DeWitt declared that young people, given over to Jesus Christ, have the potential to change the world.

"Dare to put God first in your lives," he concluded, "dare to separate yourselves from the crowd."

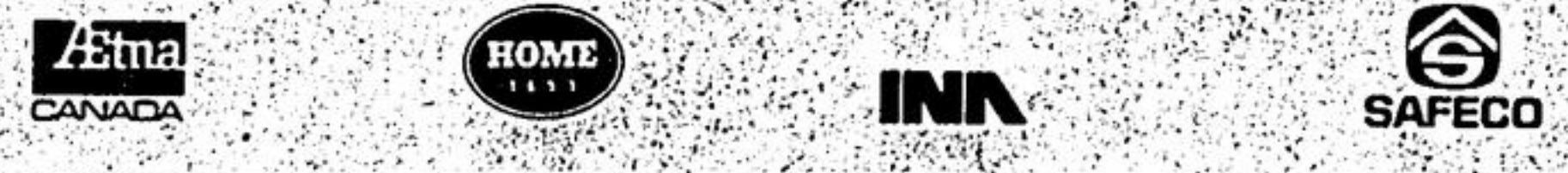
