Dining with Cal

On this crisp, frost-in-the-air autumn evening, Cathryn and I take a drive north on Hwy. 48 to the hamlet of Baldwin. A short distance south, on the west side, is Lyndhurst Park Bavarian Gardens Restaurant. Our guests remark on the size of the facility. On entering, we discover there's a large banquet room, a sauna, an indoor pool, a whirlpool, a dance floor and a fully-equipped gymnasium. To-night, I will comment only on the delicious European and Canadian cuisine, but we will surely return to this interesting recreation establishment again.

Our waitress is friendly and charming; prices are reasonable and the atmosphere is festive.

Following cocktails, we're served the most delicious fresh-made, creamy mushroom soup we've ever tasted—definitely not out of a can. The salads are crisp and full of assorted ingredients, topped with our favorite dressings.

What a pleasure to have our meals served on properly warmed plates.

The highlight of the evenings is the Bavarian Grill, consisting of schnitzel, knackwurst, pork hock, home fries and sauerkraut.

Cathryn has the Bratwurst with sauerkraut. If you enjoy hot and spicy sausage, this is the meal for you—two six-inch long sausages, surrounding a huge portion of tangy sauerkraut, edged with her favorite home fries.

My wiener schnitzel is a large and light breaded cutlet, served with my choice of potatoes, rice and french fries.

One of the Canadian selections is the special of the day—a four or six ounce bacon-wrapped filet mignon, tender and cooked to order. It comes with mixed vegetables and home fries.

Austrians make good white wine. We enjoy a chilled bottle of Blue Danube. It complements the meal.

Desserts are limited but very good. Cathryn's cherry cheese cake isn't exactly fresh but still tasty. My black forest cake, on the other hand, is moist and chocolaty.

If you enjoy German and Hungarian home-cooking or basic Canadian food, you won't be disappointed.

The Lyndhurst Park Bavarian Gardens Restaurant is located on the west side of Hwy. 48, three miles south of Sutton.

Dinner for two with wine costs from \$20 to \$35.
