





## Young people offered help

"No young person who wants to work should be prevented from doing so," says Don Cousens, MPP for York Centre.

"The Ontario government has announced a new training and on-the-job experience program for 1,500 hard-toemploy young people.

Anyone between the age of 15 and 24 with less than Grade 12 education is eligible. The program hopes to resolve the serious youth unemployment situation said Mr. Cousens.

Dr. Bette Stephenson, Minister of Education, who announced the program said it is aimed at young people who left school early and are now having difficulty finding a job.

"The program combines basic academic

upgrading, skills training and life-skills counselling with on-the-job experience in businesses and industries to give these young men and women a new chance at finding steady employment," the minister

Trainees will be paid an allowance of

\$100-a-week throughout the program which lasts up to 42 weeks. Part of the time is spent acquiring job training and experience with participating businesses. There is no cost to employees.

The Ontario Youth Opportunities will be pleased to assist any young person looking for employment.






