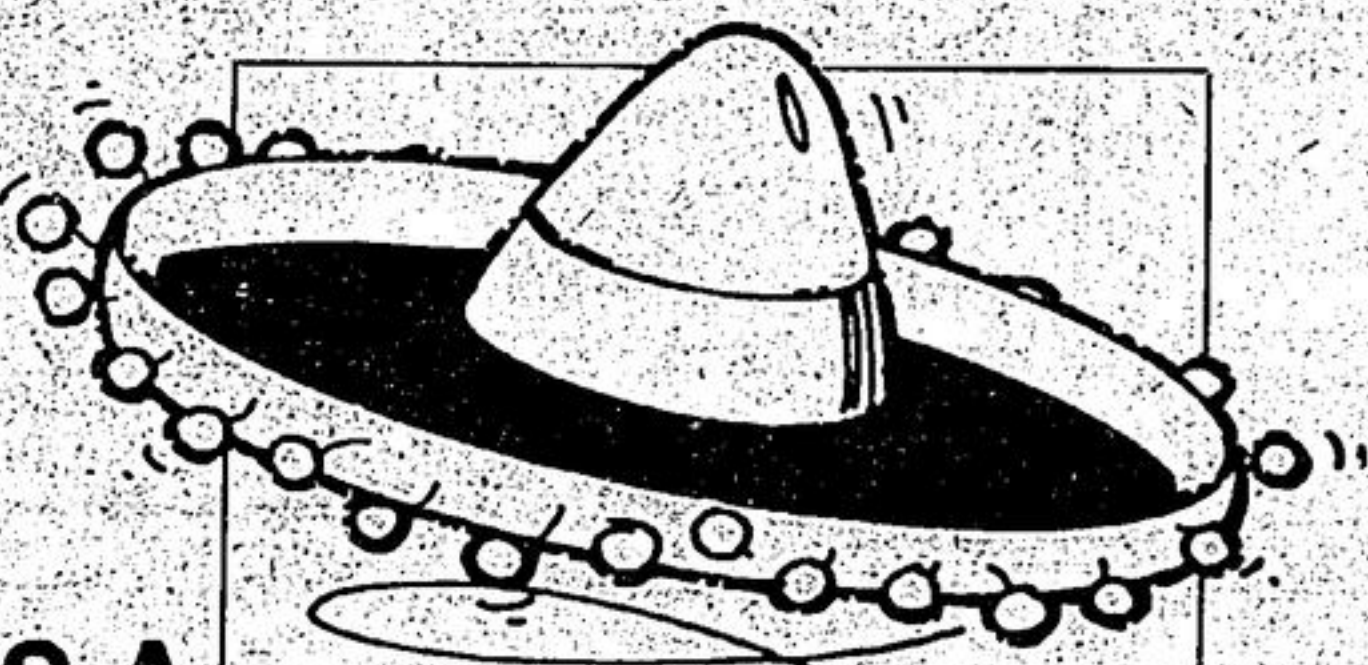
"Girl Next Door"

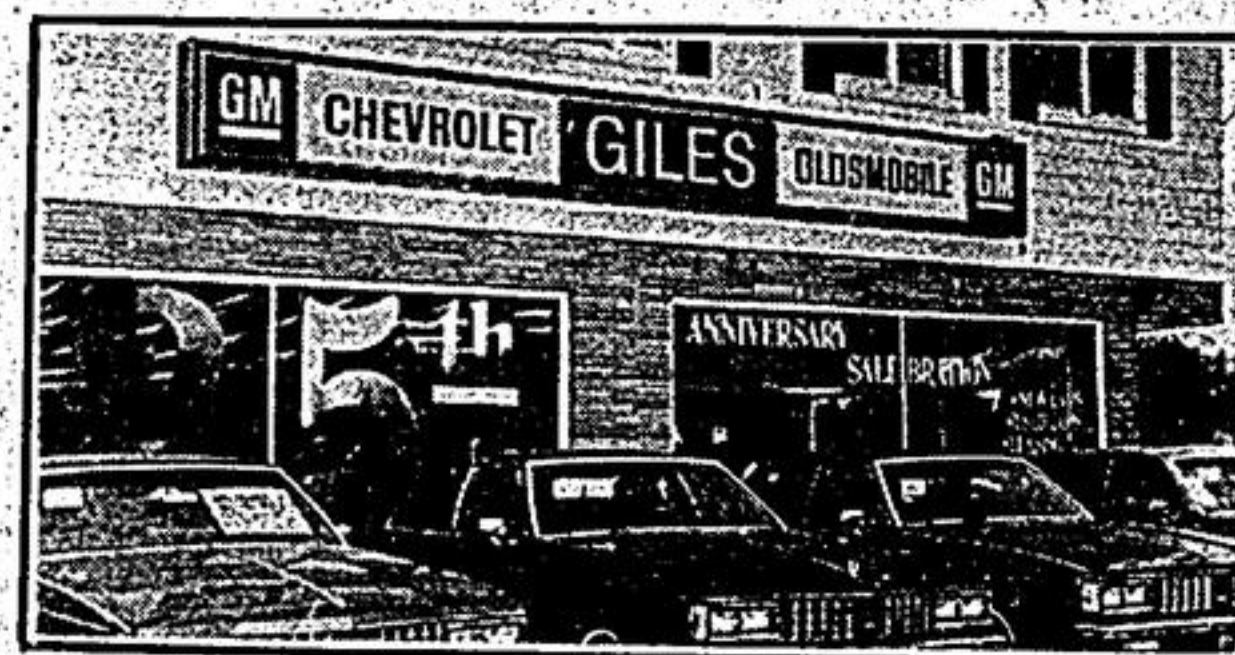
