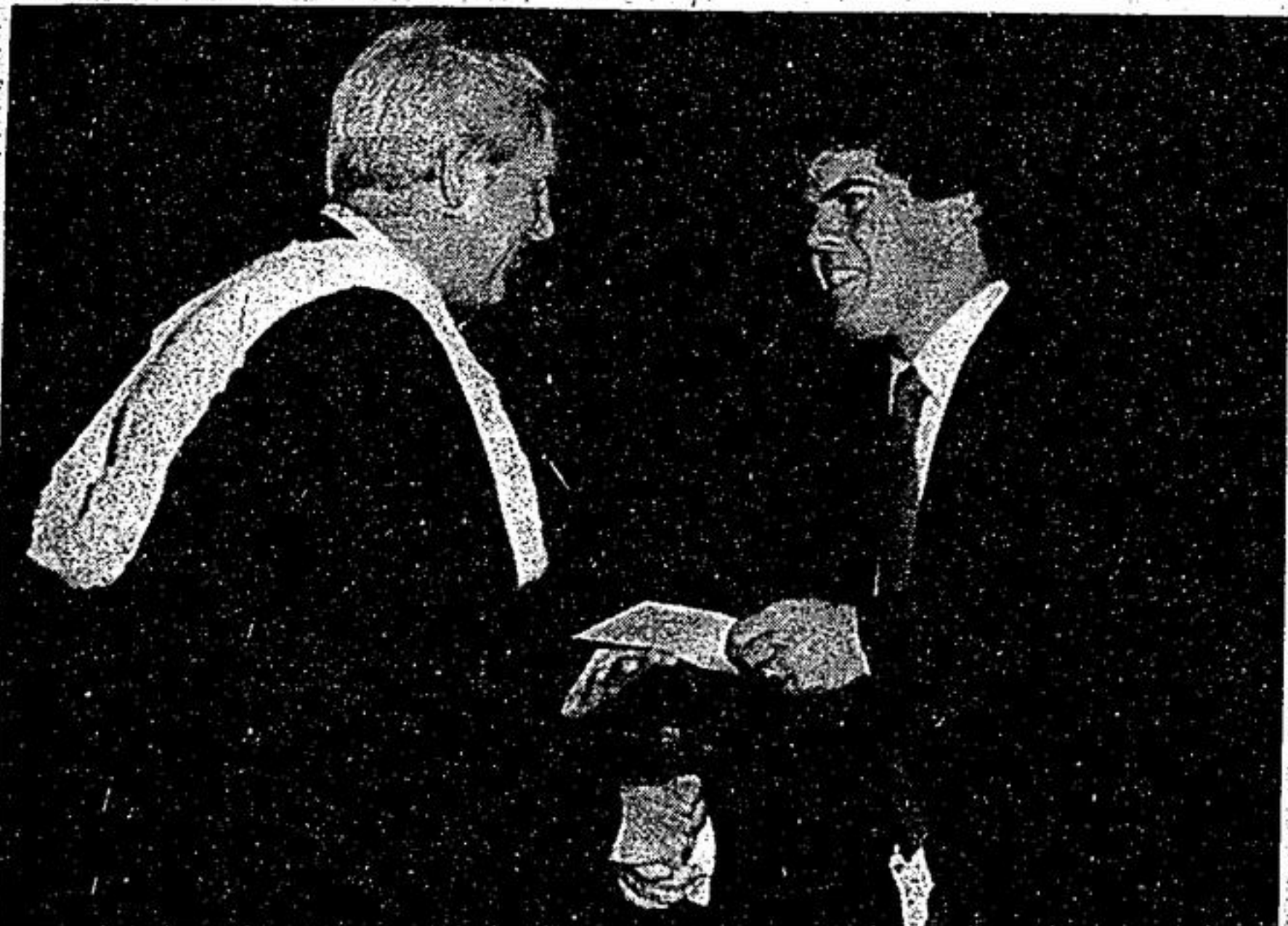
STOUFFVILLE — To many, the end of Grade 12 marks the conclusion of enrolment at Stouffville Dist. Secondary School.
