

Scouts quiz politicians

UXBRIDGE — Does the Township get half of the money our parents pay for a new car?

That was one question that caught local municipal officials off guard when the first Uxbridge Boy Scout troop visited the Council Chambers, Thursday evening.

The Scouts sat in on a number of committee meetings involving members of Uxbridge Twp. Council, then took part in a question-and-answer session.

The politicians fielded queries on subjects ranging from services for rural residents to the function of the press at Council meetings.

When questioned about the car-tax, Council members quickly set the record straight on just how they spend the tax revenue they do receive.

Only about 27 cents of every tax dollar actually goes into Twp. coffers. Administrator Ron Kester confirmed. Over half of the total goes to the school board to cover educational costs and the remaining 25 per cent helps finance
