Diane and Judi are pleased with the reception to date, the majority through referrals. Their contact numbers are 294-4403 (Diane) and 640-5309 (Judi).

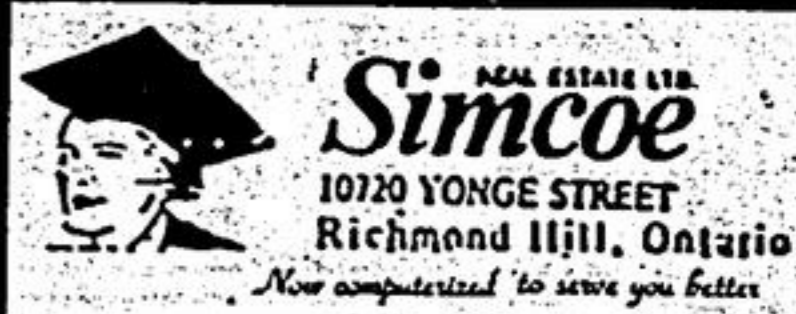
Torontair to expand service
