**STOFFVILLE:**— Would you believe, 90,000 checkouts at the Whitchurch-Stouffville Public Library so far this year?

This record was established for the first time at 11:15 a.m., Saturday morning. The honor came to 13-year-old Mark Burdon of 6 Elliott Street, Ballantrae. Board chairman Paul Roney described the feat as "a milestone—an outstanding accomplishment."

## Dining with Cal

While enjoying the snow flurries and blowing winds, my thoughts wander back to the warm beaches and laid back lifestyle of our Mexican vacations. Business commitments make a trip this year impossible but fortunately, thanks to Viva Zapata Restaurant, we only have to drive as far as 2300 John Street, Thornhill for an authentic Mexican "la cena" (meal).

Sangria, an excellent accompaniment to Mexican food is our choice of beverage. Borrowing from their menu, here is Zapata's recipe. To make a litre, use at least a 60 oz. pitcher, squeeze a whole orange and lemon. Add about an ounce of brandy and 1 1/2 to two ounces of sugar syrup. Add wine—any good full bodied red then just a spritz of soda water. (Don't drown it...if you wanted soda pop you would have ordered it!) Now add ice. Give it a stir and pour. Refreshing!

The menu is great reading and very descriptive, beckoning us to sample everything. My appetizer is Jalapeno con queso described as 'kind of like a Mexican fondue' contains melted cheese and hot peppers served with crisp corn chips. It's delicious but rather hot. The cold sangria is much appreciated.

Cathryn plays it safe and tries the guacamole dip, a refreshing concoction of avocado and seasonings in which to dunk crisp corn chips.

For my main course, I enjoy the Seafood Testada. It is an ample serving of shrimp, crab meat and scallops sitting in a pleasant sauce on a crisp tortilla.

Cathryn decides to have something hot and spicy and orders the Burrito. It's a soft tortilla rolled around peppery chile con carne with refritos. She makes it even hotter by adding some special sauce which is conveniently on our table. These delicious meals come with Mexican style rice, habit-forming refritos (refried beans) and a crispy green salad.

Cathryn and I share one of the delicious desserts offered called the 'Top Banana'. A great combination of bananas and pineapple briefly deep-fried then covered with hot rum sauce and vanilla ice cream. Very rich but excellent.
