MARKHAM HYDRO ELECTRIC COMMISSION 1985 RATE SCHEDULE

Ontario Hydro has announced the wholesale cost of power to Markham Hydro will increase by 8.3% on January 1, 1985. Approximately 1.4% of the increase is to subsidize the Ontario Hydro rural rate and an additional 1.6% has been included to cover a Provincial water resources levy.

Markham Hydro Commission through careful budgeting and close scrutiny of capital and operating costs has been successful in absorbing a portion of the increase even though utility operating costs are substantially higher.

After careful consideration the Commission has recommended an average rate increase of 7.7% for residential and 7.8% for general service customers. Averages will vary depending on consumption and the increases if approved by Ontario Hydro will take effect January 1, 1985.
