

Suspended sentence for woman after guilty plea

UXBRIDGE TWP. — An Uxbridge woman has been granted a suspended sentence following her conviction on counts of attempted murder and aggravated assault.

A five-year prohibition on the possession of firearms, ammunition and explosives was imposed.

The court also directed Mrs. Mulgrew to refrain from communications with her husband, 46-year-old Henry Mulgrew.

Mrs. Mulgrew, 1984, court was told, stabbed her husband during a domestic dispute at a Zephyr-area residence on Aug. 15, 1984. The offence of aggravated assault stems from another similar incident back in May of the same year.

Supreme Court Justice Henry placed Tuna Selina Mulgrew, 44, on a three-year probationary period during sentencing at Whitby, Friday.

Mrs. Mulgrew pleaded guilty to the charges at a Jan. 14 trial.

Justice Henry stipulated that the Uxbridge woman must receive medical treatment at Toronto's Clarke Institute of Psychiatry. Staff approval is required before she can be released.
