

Cohon guest speaker

George Cohon, president and chief executive of McDonald's Restaurants of Canada, will be addressing the Markham Board of Trade dinner meeting at the Bayview Golf and Country Club, Wednesday, Feb. 20.

Mr. Cohon's topic will be McDonald's past, present and future.

Mr. Cohon grew up in Chicago, and attended Drake University and graduated with a Bachelor of Science degree. He later attained a Juris Doctorate degree from the Northwestern School of Law.

From 1961 to 1967, he practiced law in the United States. He also received an Alumni Distinguished Service Award from Drake University.

In 1968, Mr. Cohon moved to Canada as a licensee of McDonald's Corporation for Eastern Canada. The next three years

showed a rapid growth in the corporation's eastern outlets.

In July, 1970, the McDonald's Corporation acquired Mr. Cohon's license agreement. He stayed on as President of the Ontario division until the Western Canada Restaurants were purchased by McDonald's Corporation, at which time, McDonald's Restaurants of Canada Ltd. was formed.

It is the McDonald's success and how it was achieved that will be the focus of Mr. Cohon's address. He has admitted "McDonald's has become a religion to me, it's certainly more than a job."

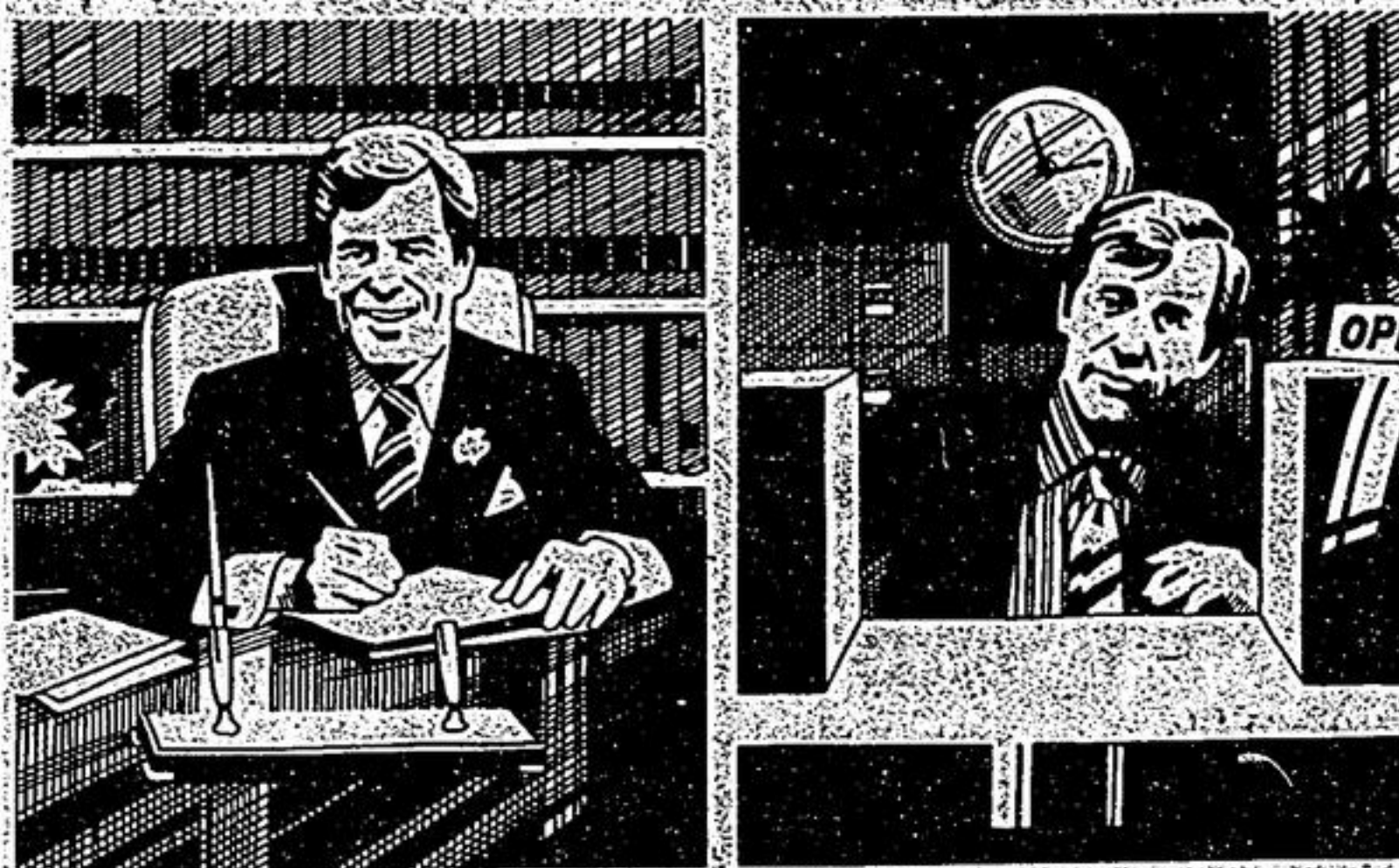
