

# An Open Letter to The Customers of Markham Pharmacy & IGA

We, the owners of Markham Pharmacy and the Markham I.G.A., are asking you — our customers — for your help in assuring that you continue to have access to adequate parking space.

The Town of Markham has placed us in a dilemma regarding the provision of parking for you. We have always provided free parking for your convenience on our private lot, and lived up to the requirements of the relevant zoning by-law.

Recently, however, the Town of Markham has issued a building permit to allow the construction of a 80-seat restaurant, a banquet hall and four boutiques in the old Towne Cinema building without making any additional provision for parking space for this development's customers. While the Town has indicated an intention to consider purchasing the small white house behind the Bank of Montreal to provide additional parking in future, this purchase could take several years to implement. Meantime, there seems little doubt that the hundreds of patrons who will be attracted to the new development in the Towne Cinema building will use our parking lot — and your parking spaces — automatically.

We value your patronage, and believe that we owe you the convenience of easy and accessible parking.

In view of the fact that the Town recently required that Sherwood Plaza provide an additional 17 parking spots for two small stores, we find it illogical that a development the size of the one contemplated for the Towne Cinema be approved with no concrete provision for parking made.

We intend to do everything we can to ensure that the parking spaces we have provided for you, our customers, will be used by you — and no one else. To that end, we would be very grateful for any expression of support from you — whether a phone-call or letter — in this matter.

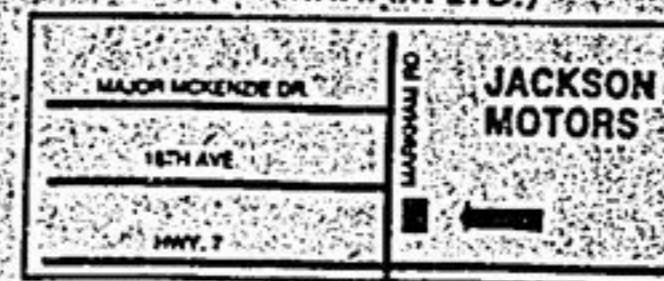
