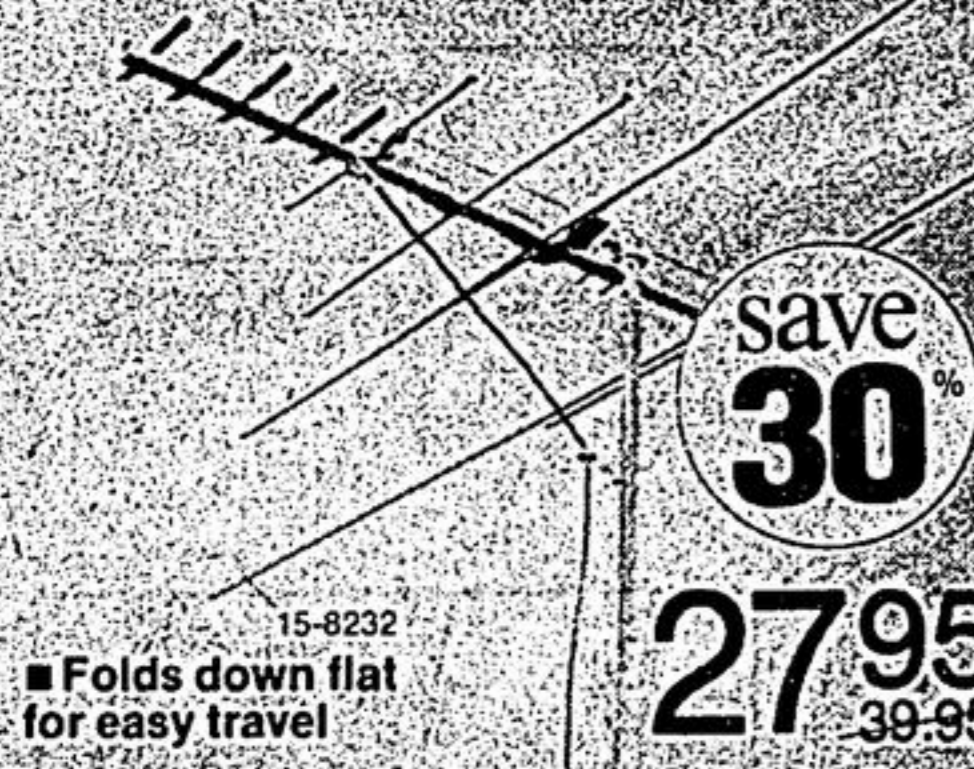
What lies beyond?

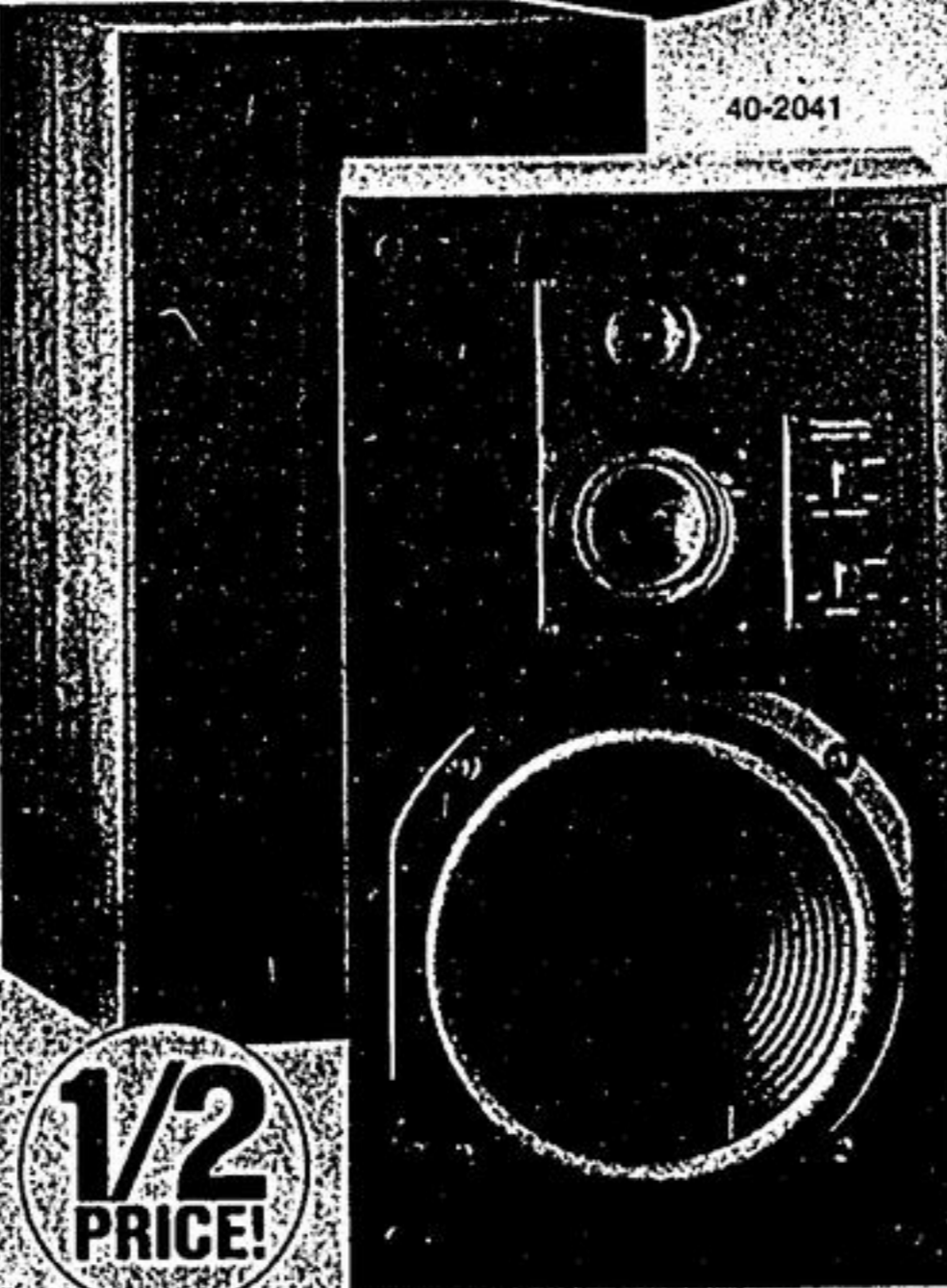
