event.

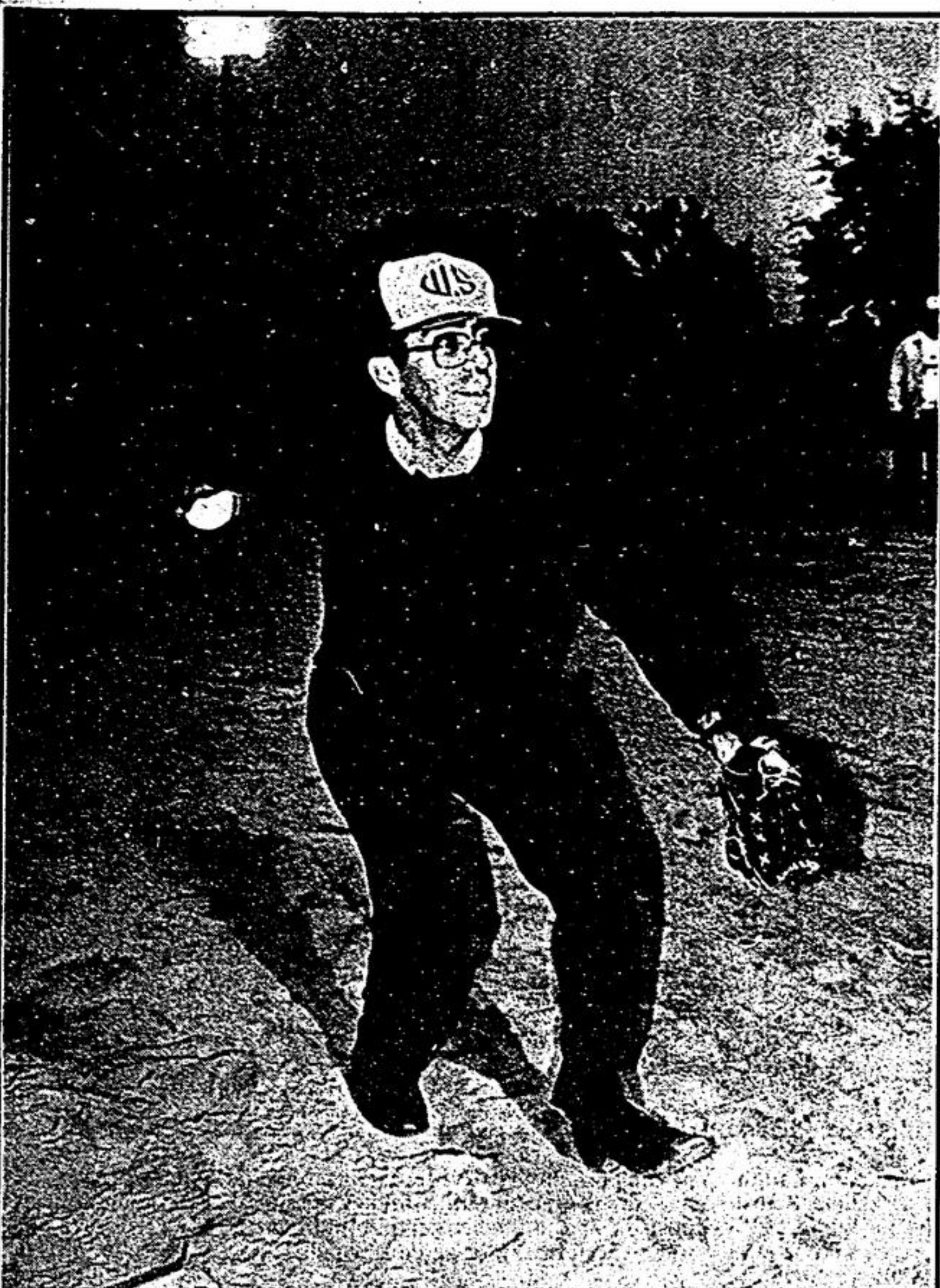
I was ecstatic to see the amount of space you gave over to this 'happening'. I'm sure the committee must have been pleased also.

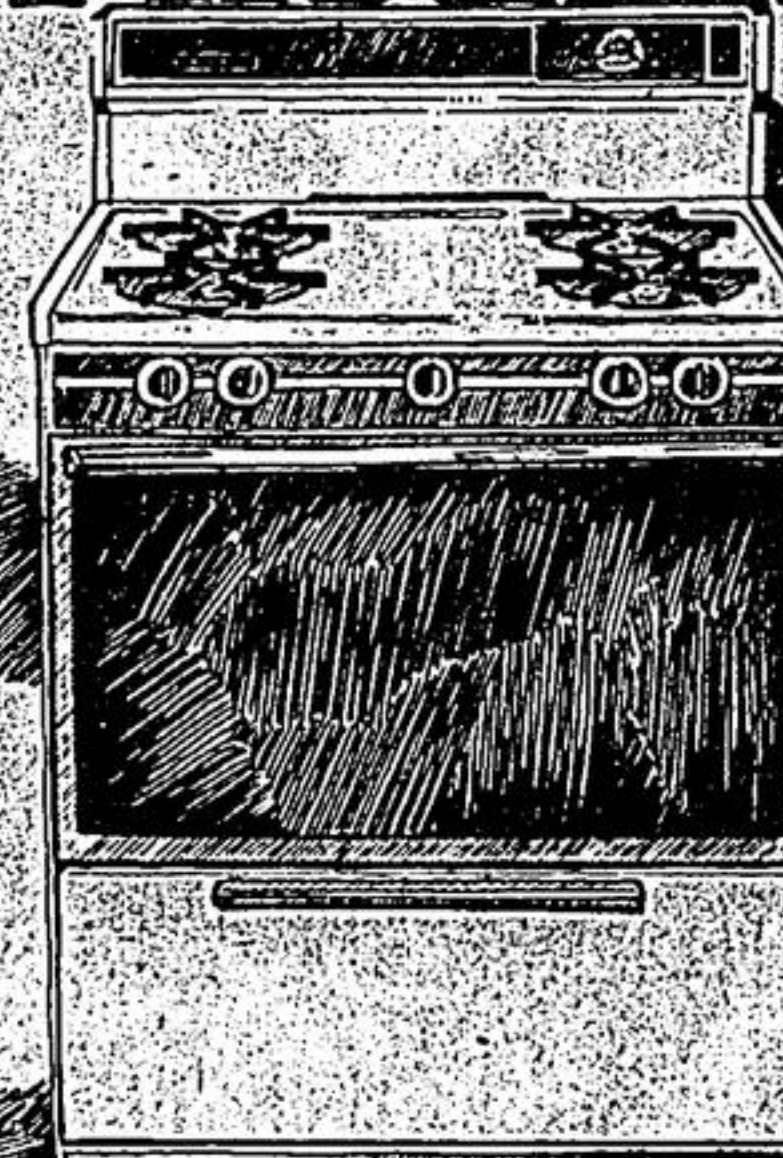

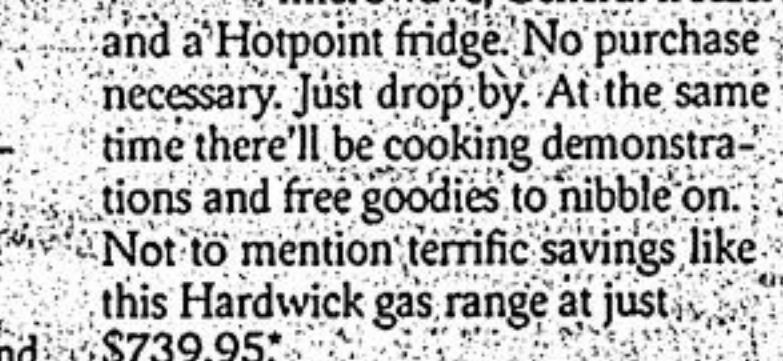

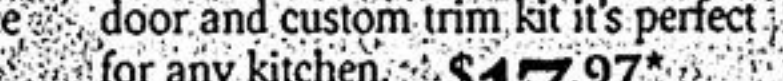
