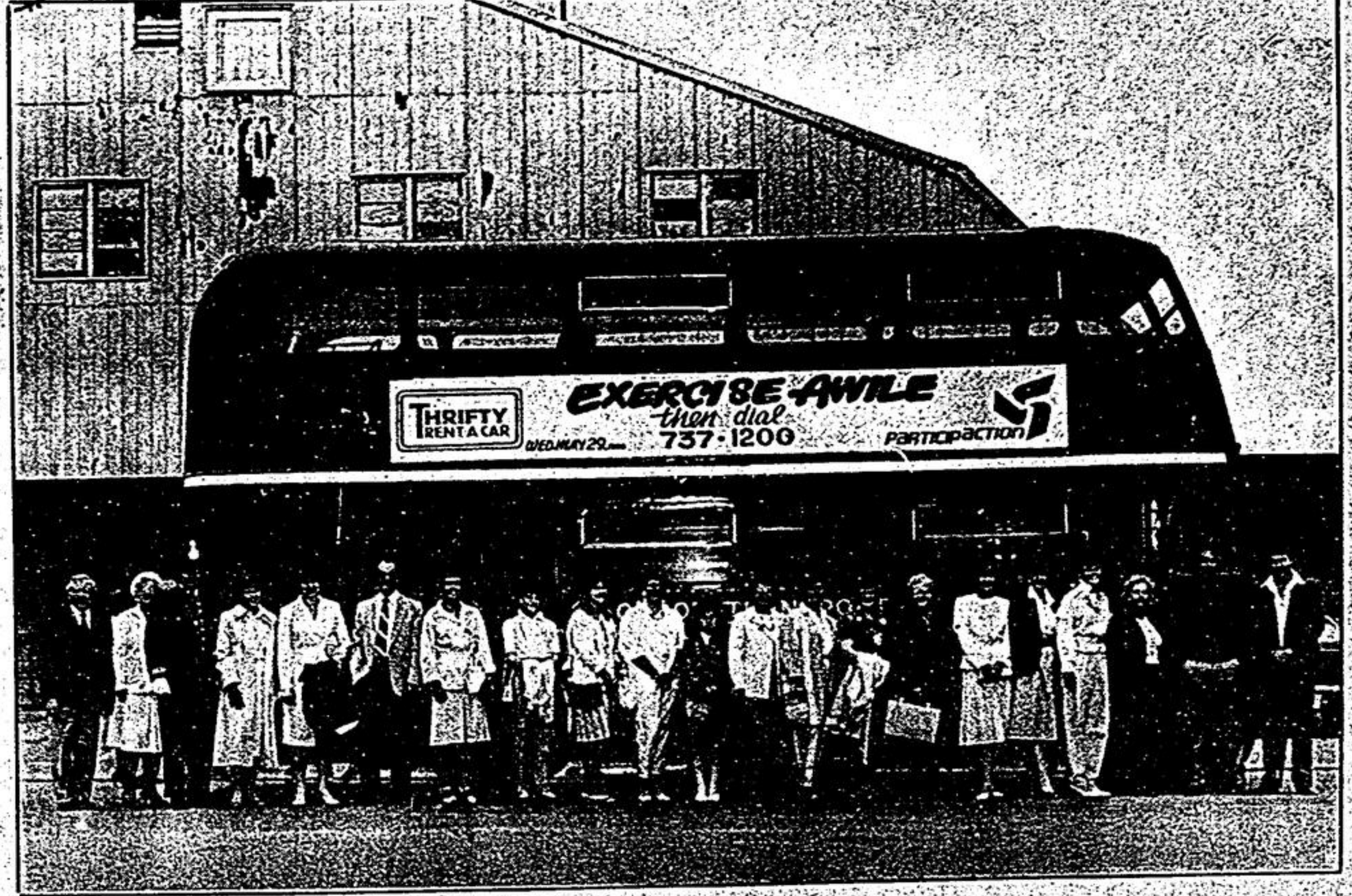


Busload of friends at graduation
