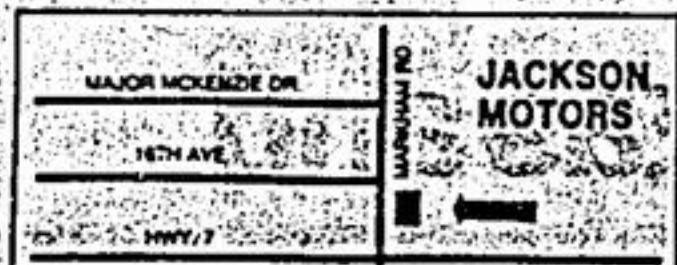

## Not enough hair

STOUFFVILLE — The west-end building that now accommodates the Sign of the Steer restaurant and an auction arena will soon be home to a third business.

A zoning change to General Commercial (GC) from the present Highway Commercial (C2) will permit operation of a barber shop at 394 Main Street West.

Tony Caradonna of Maple and Dominique Ritorto, Woodbridge, plan to move their barber shop across the street from its present location at the A&P plaza.

But Stouffville beauty salon operator Andy Caramanico voiced his objection during a public meeting May 21.

Mr Caramanico said he feels Stouffville already has enough hair-cutting establishments to service the existing need.

"If there's one thing this town doesn't need it's another beauty salon," he said. "We're turning this town into a big shopping mall, with no people to shop!"

Lawyer Gord Ness, appearing on behalf of the building's owner (Glofos & Son Investment Limited) and the prospective tenants, agreed that there's a surplus of beauty salons. But he noted that Caradonna and Ritorto plan to operate a barber shop only.
