**Block Parents meet**

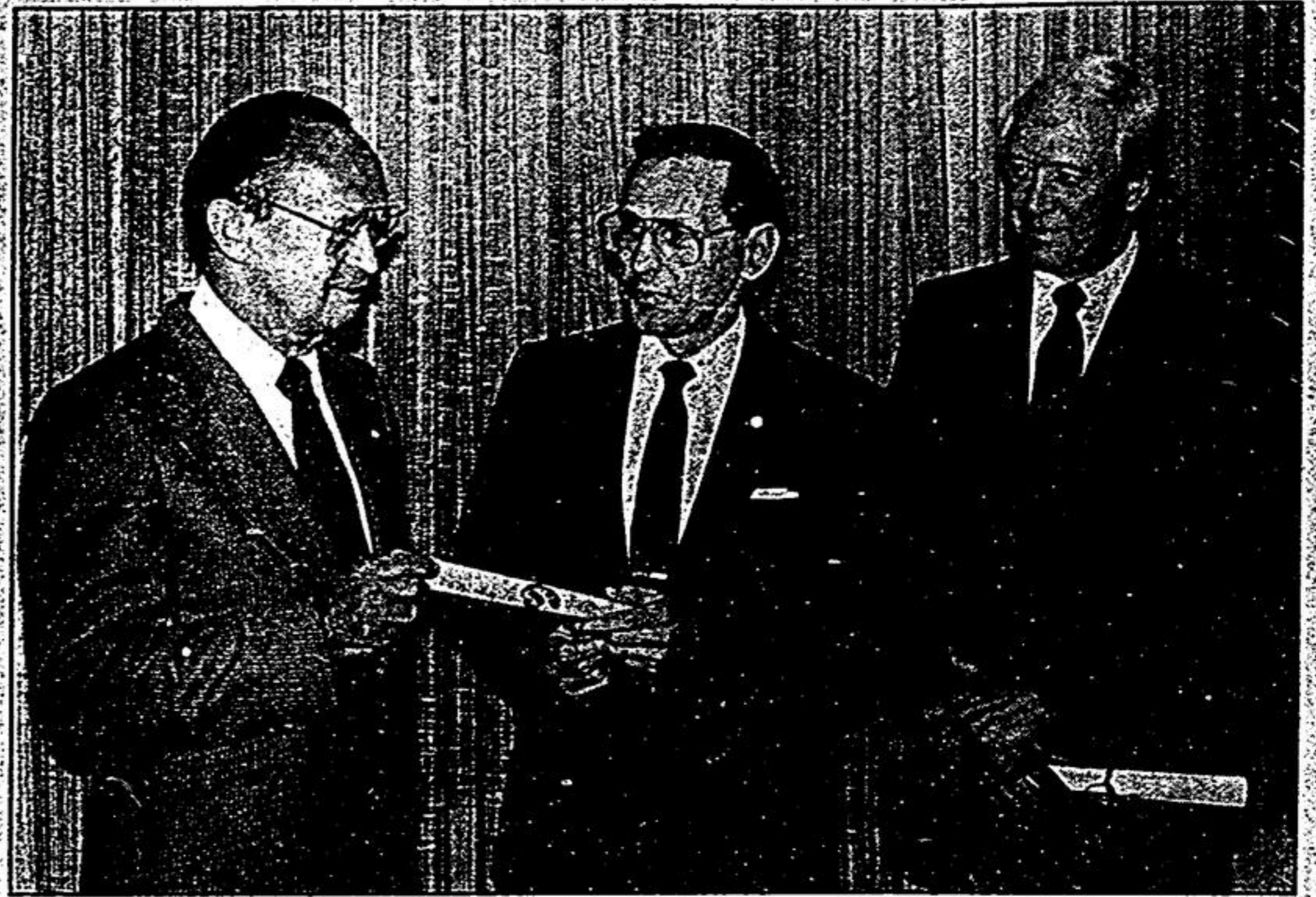

**Discussed again**

**Lights keep on flashing**

**STOUFFVILLE** — Every once in a while, the pedestrian traffic light on Main Street signals debate within Council. At a recent discussion, it flashed both green, amber and red as members advised 'go', 'caution' and 'stop'.

Councillor Jim Rae said entry onto Main Street, particularly from the south, was becoming increasingly difficult. He recommended the light be relocated at the intersection of Market and Main. Councillor Fran Sainsbury agreed, but for a diffe-

rent reason. She said the move would free up seven additional parking spaces.

Mayor Tom Wood said Council must decide whether its priorities are people or cars. The present location, he said, allows pedestrians to move from one side of the street to the other.

"It's a costly item that shouldn't be entered into lightly," warned Councillor Jim Sanders. His motion that prices be obtained on relocating the light to Market Street, Civic Avenue or Church Street, was approved.
