



ONTARIO STRAWBERRIES

STRAWBERRY GINGER CREAM PIE
9 7/8" cm pie
8 oz. gingersnap cookies, crushed into crumbs (approx: 2 cups/500 mL) (250g)
1/3 cup butter (preferably unsalted) (75 mL)
Filling:
1 qt. fresh strawberries, hulled (1 L)
1 envelope unflavoured gelatin (1)
1/3 cup rum or water (75 mL)
2 eggs (2)
1/2 cup sugar (125 mL)
2 tbsp. all-purpose flour (25 mL)
1 1/2 cups milk, hot (375 mL)
1 tsp. pure vanilla extract (5 mL)
1 cup whipping cream (250 mL)

1/3 cup finely chopped candied ginger (75mL)
Garnish:
1/2 cup strawberry or raspberry jam or jelly, strained, springs of fresh mint - optional

Combine cookie crumbs with melted butter; pat into bottom and sides of a 9 7/8" cm pie dish. Bake at 350°F/180°C for 10 minutes. Cool.
Sprinkle gelatin over rum in a saucepan. Soften 5 minutes; heat gently to dissolve. Beat eggs with sugar in the top of a double boiler. Beat in flour; slowly whisk in hot milk. Cook over simmering water until custard thickens. Beat in gelatin and vanilla; cool over a larger bowl filled with ice and water. Mixture should be cool but not yet set.
Slice 1/3 of the berries; place in cooled pie shell. Halve remaining berries and reserve for the top.
Whip cream until light and fold into gelatin base along with ginger. Spoon into pie shell and refrigerate one hour.
Arrange reserved berries over top of pie. Brush berries with jam. Decorate with sprigs of mint. Chill 2 hours or longer.
