

## Never on Sunday?

**STOUFFVILLE** — Lilly-Ann Landry's "Place of Amusement" at 61 Main Street East, (Bowling Alley Block) is open for business on Sundays. Also, it accommodates 22 amusement machines rather than a maximum of sixteen. Both uses are contrary to the Town's Licensing Bylaw.

On Thursday, the owner-operator appeared before Council to discuss complaints.

He said that to remove six machines would make a sizeable dent in the business. He noted too the arcade had been operating on the Sabbath for four years.

"Why wasn't something said when we took over?" the licence applicant asked.

Mayor Tom Wood explained the Town only acts on complaints or when a new application is received.

"This isn't a fortune-making thing," the speaker protested.

Council agreed that, until the operator has an opportunity to address the problems and the Town has a chance to consider amendments to the bylaw, the business should carry on as before.
