## McMichael gallery caters to youngsters

For those youngsters that show an interest in art, the McMichael Canadian Collection in Kleinburg is holding programs that may bring out their hidden talents.

The Special Land Forms program, designed for ages six to nine years, explores shapes in paintings by the Group of Seven and in our environment. Each child, accompanied by a parent, can take part in a variety of activities and discussions.

The program runs Aug. 10, 17 and 24 from 1:30 to 3:30 p.m. Cost is \$5 per day or \$15 for all three days. Registration fees for McMichael members is \$3.50 per day or \$10 for all three days.

Outdoor sketching classes will be running July 14, 21 and 28 for children 11 to 14. The course is designed for all levels of ability. The fee is \$10 per person, \$7.50 for McMichael members and includes materials. The program runs from 9:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.
