Her duties as dairy princess will include attendance at agricultural fairs, and public school speaking engagements on topics such as nutrition. She'll also talk at various men's and women's group functions.

"My job is representing farmers in our county," says Sharon, whose family runs a large dairy farm and

auction business in Uxbridge. "I think it'll be fun teaching kids in school."

In 1986, she'll be among 54 Ontario dairy princesses representing Ontario's counties at the provincial CNE competition. A win there would lead to an exciting year of appearances on behalf of the Ontario Milk Marketing Board.

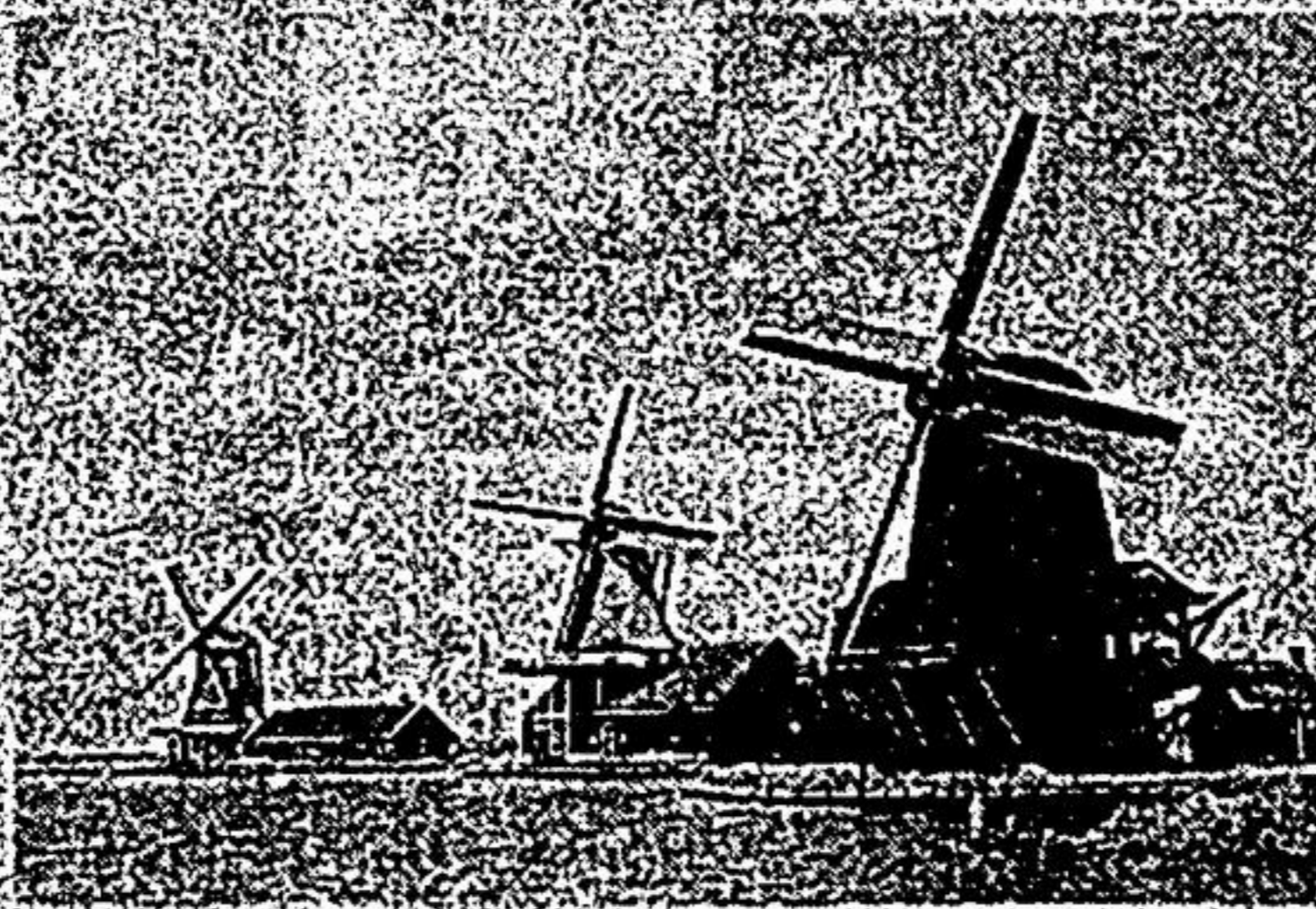
