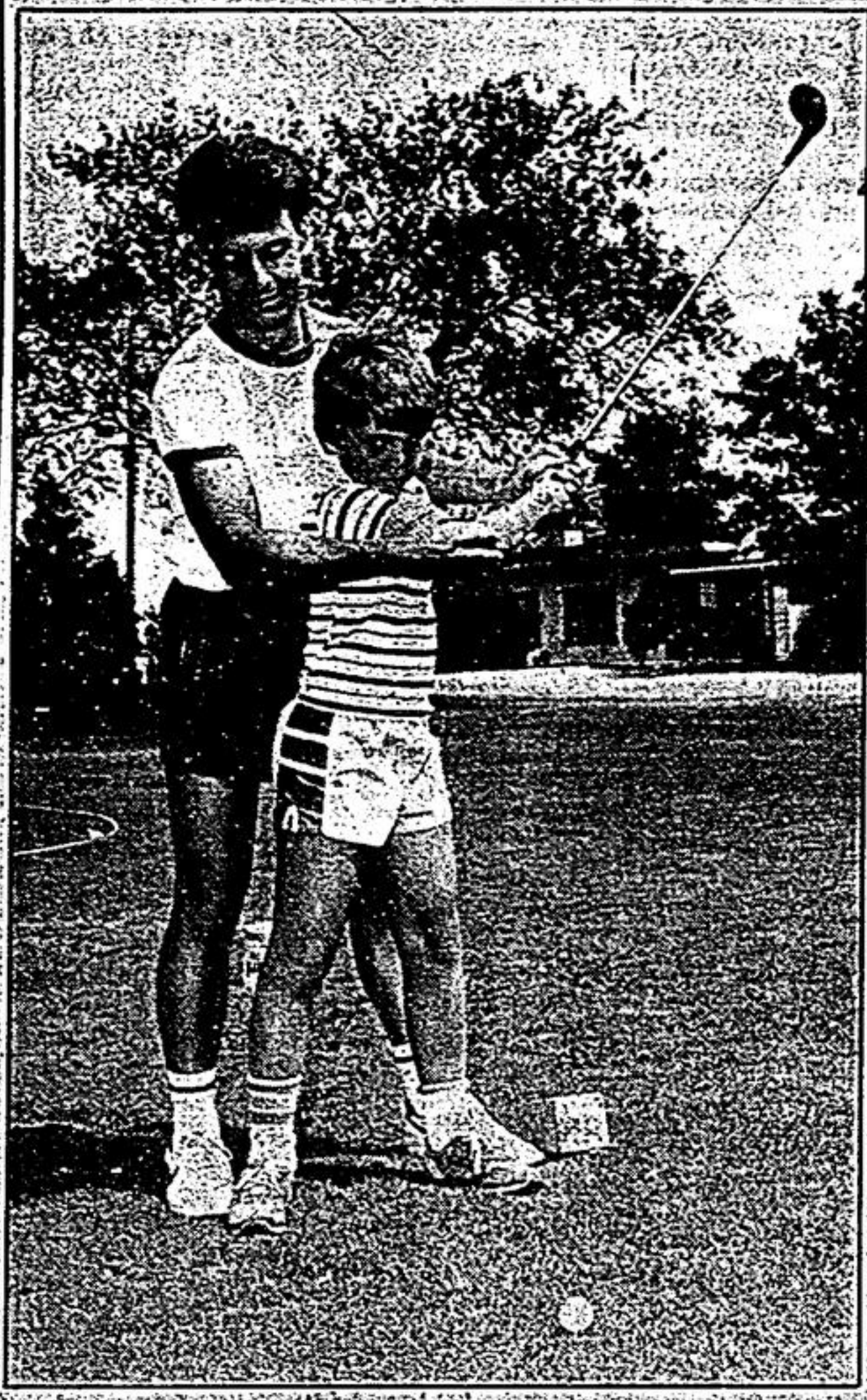

PUBLIC MEETING CONCERNING A PROPOSED OFFICIAL PLAN AMENDMENT AND ZONING BY-LAW AMENDMENT

NOTICE OF MEETING
 TAKE NOTICE that the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville will hold a public meeting on Wednesday, September 4th, 1985 at 7:30 p.m. in the Lemorville Community Centre in Lemorville (1/4 of a mile north of the Bethesda Sideroad east of McCowan Road) to make available adequate information to the public regarding, and to consider, the proposed Amendments to be passed pursuant to Sections 17 and 34 of the Planning Act.

SUBJECT PROPERTY
 The subject property, comprising approximately 550 acres, is located in Lots 3, 4 and 5, Concession 4 with frontages on Woodbine Avenue, Bethesda Sideroad and Warden Avenue.

EXPLANATORY NOTE
PROPOSED OFFICIAL PLAN AMENDMENT
 The proposed Amendment would change the land use designation on the subject property from Recreational Commercial and Rural to Estate Residential.

In addition, the proposed Amendment would change the Estate Residential land use policies to permit a maximum 350 lot subdivision with a minimum lot area of 2415 square metres (25,995 square feet), serviced by a piped water system and integrated with a golf course, on the subject property.

The proposed Amendment results from a revised proposal by the Firefighters Bethesda Group, and is further to a public meeting held on May 1st, 1984.

EXPLANATORY NOTE
PROPOSED ZONING BY-LAW AMENDMENT
 The proposed Amendment would change the zoning in the Restricted Area By-law from Rural: RU to Rural Residential (7): RR(7) and Open Space: O on the subject property.

A Rural Residential (7): RR(7) zone permits detached dwelling units and group homes on a lot with a minimum area of 2785 square metres (29,977 square feet) and a minimum frontage of 30 metres (98.4 feet). Notwithstanding the RR(7) zone requirements, a minimum lot area of 2415 square metres (25,995 square feet) will be permitted on the subject property.

Notwithstanding the uses permitted in an Open Space - O zone, only golf courses, public and private recreation centres, and buildings and structures accessory to the foregoing including clubhouse facilities, will be permitted on the subject property.

REPRESENTATION
 ANY PERSON may attend the public meeting and make written or oral representation either in support of or in opposition to the proposed Amendments. If you are unable to attend, written submissions will be received up to the time of the meeting. Written submissions should include a request for further notification, if so desired.

 ADDITIONAL INFORMATION relating to the proposed Amendments is available for inspection at this office during regular business hours (8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.). If you have any questions, please contact the Planning Department at this office.
