Without Plan means chaos

STOUFFVILLE — Does the Town's Official Plan discriminate against rural land owners wishing severances?

Ward 2 Councillor Ron Robb thinks so. He feels the Plan "stinks".

Asked for an opinion on Councillor Robb's comment, Mayor Tom Wood said the Official Plan was approved by the people before being endorsed by the Town. He feels that if it's too restrictive with respect to rural residential build-up, then it can be corrected.

"We should take another look at it," he said, "but as of now, we must abide by it. There'd be chaos if we ignored it."

Councillor Robb was angered by Council's refusal to allow a father permission to build a second house on sixteen acres for his daughter and son-in-law at the corner of the Vandorf Road and Don Mills Road.

"We fall all over ourselves when a subdivider comes in; yet local people who've lived here for years, can't sever a small piece of land for their families. It's a crime," Councillor Robb said.
