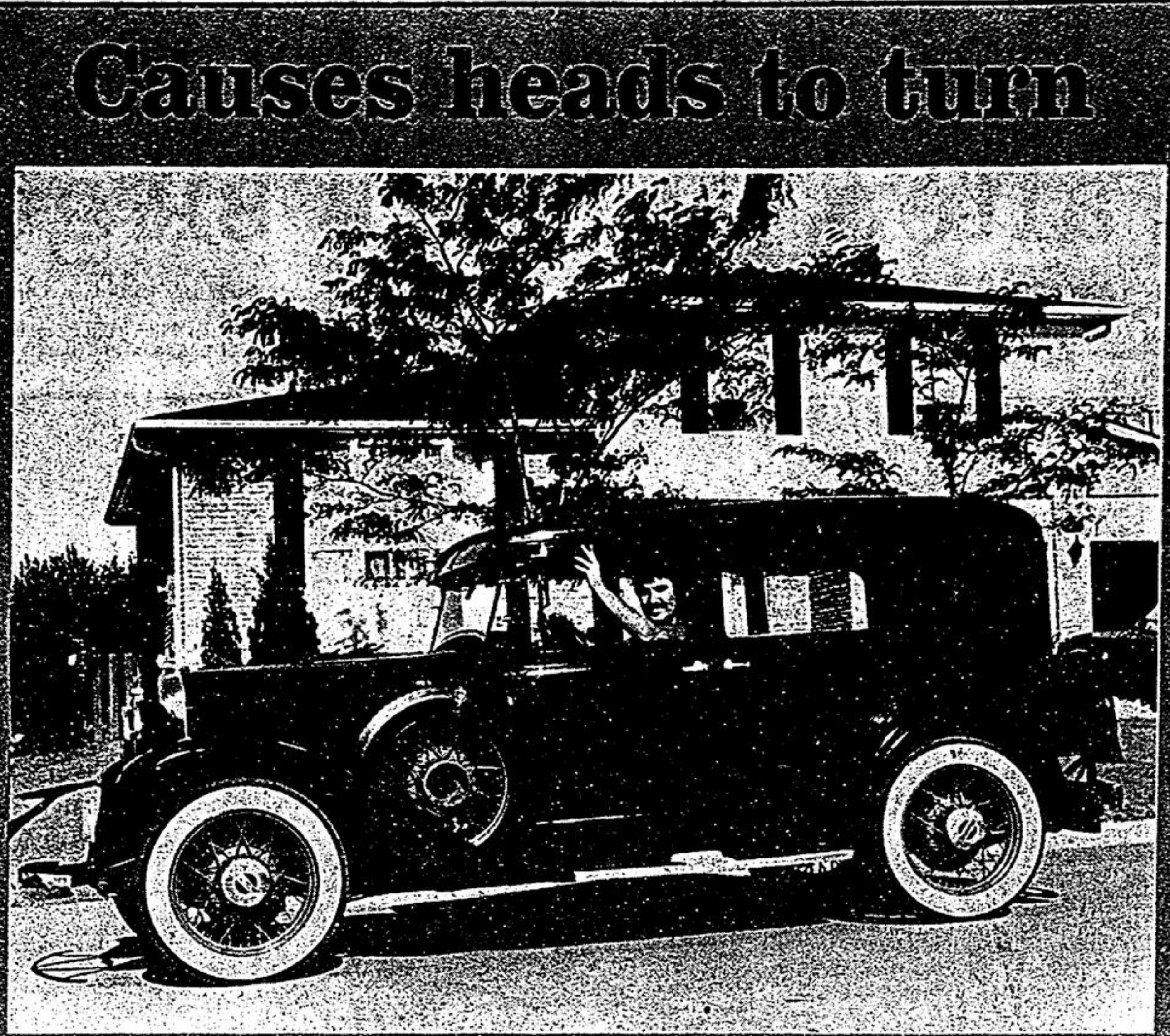
P.S.-One other point. Since when is incumbency grounds for re-election? I'm sure there are many Liberals in Ottawa who could explain this concept in more detail!
