## Minor hockey sees changes this year

Hockey season is fast approaching! Now is the time to start thinking about registering your son or daughter for the 1985-86 season.

At a recent meeting of the Whitechurch-Stouffville Minor Hockey Association, several items of interest were discussed and approved.

The following agenda might help answer those pre-season questions.

Rates for the 1985-86 season are listed below according to division/year of birth/rate:  
 Pre-Novice/first year players/\$110, Novice/1976/\$130, Atom/1974-75/\$140, Pee-Wee/1972-73/\$140, Bantam/1970-71/\$150, Midget/1968-69/\$150, Juvenile/1966-67/\$150, Family Rate/Two highest rates/ max \$300.

The above age categories reflect the one year increase in age limit as passed by the Ontario Minor Hockey Association.

All-Star team members will pay an additional \$50 on signing a rep card.

Proof of registration will be required for all players attending an all-star try-out at the beginning of the season.

Registration will be held at Latham Hall on September 10 and 16 (7-9 p.m.); and September 21 (9 a.m. - noon).

Skate and equipment exchange will be held during registration times.

Anyone wishing to apply for coach, manager or trainer on a rep team is requested to send a letter of application to P.O. Box 833, Stouffville on or before August 15.

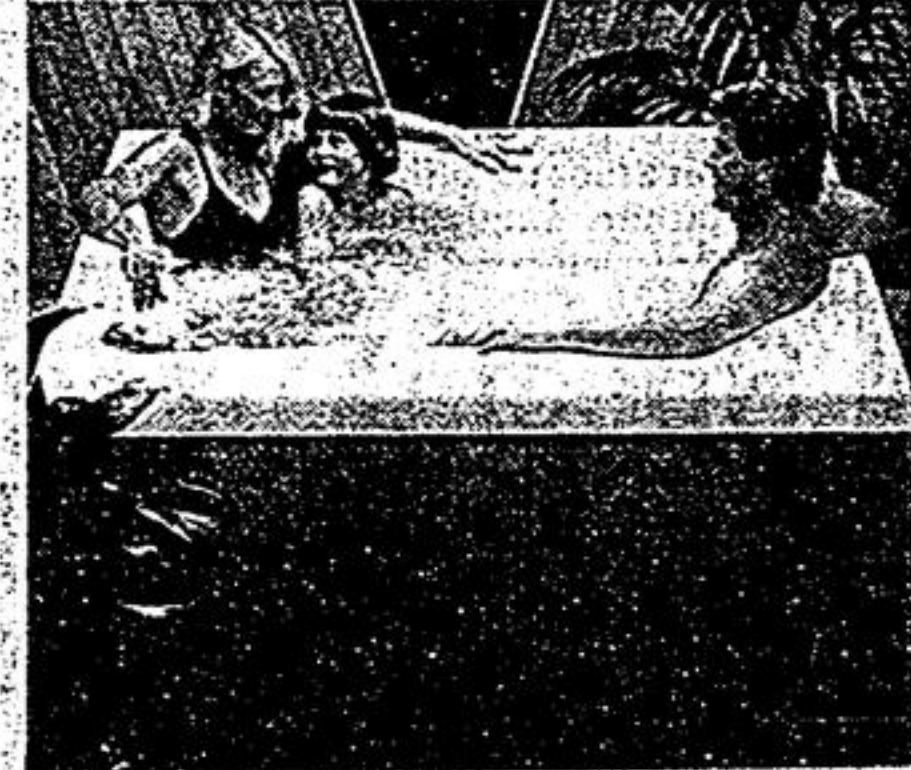

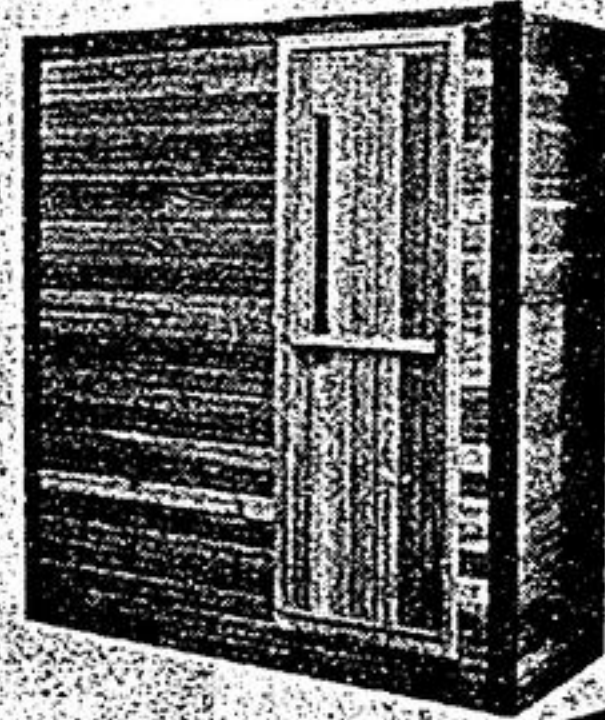
