Survey on airport lands

Positive results

PICKERING — The majority of rural non-farmers residing on airport lands would buy their homes back if given the opportunity, a federally-funded survey indicates.

This trend has been identified by a group of agriculture students and faculty from the University of Guelph during a poll of tenants on the expropriated land.

The Pickering Airport-Lands Revitalization Committee (PARC) study team has solicited about 355 responses, 250 from non-farmers, 65 from farmers on-site and another 40 from off-site agri-

culturalists. Survey results show that renters feel the federal government has worked regularly, but shoddily, in maintaining the 18,000 acres of land it purchased for the now-shelved Pickering Airport.

Though the majority of tenants feel the government has done "quite a bit" of work on the properties, PARC field manager Grant McGregor said, "the quality of the workmanship is perceived to be poor."

Study coordinator George Penfold, a professor at the University of Guelph, said the re-

spondents have been helpful and approachable. Of the first 100 people contacted for interviews, only three refused to co-operate.

Final survey results will be tabulated and turned over to the PARC committee, a group of concerned citizens headed by Ontario riding Member of Parliament, Scott Fennell.

It's hoped that all agricultural and managerial problems can be identified by the end of fall. Suggestions for workable alternatives will then be presented to the government for evaluation and selection.
