

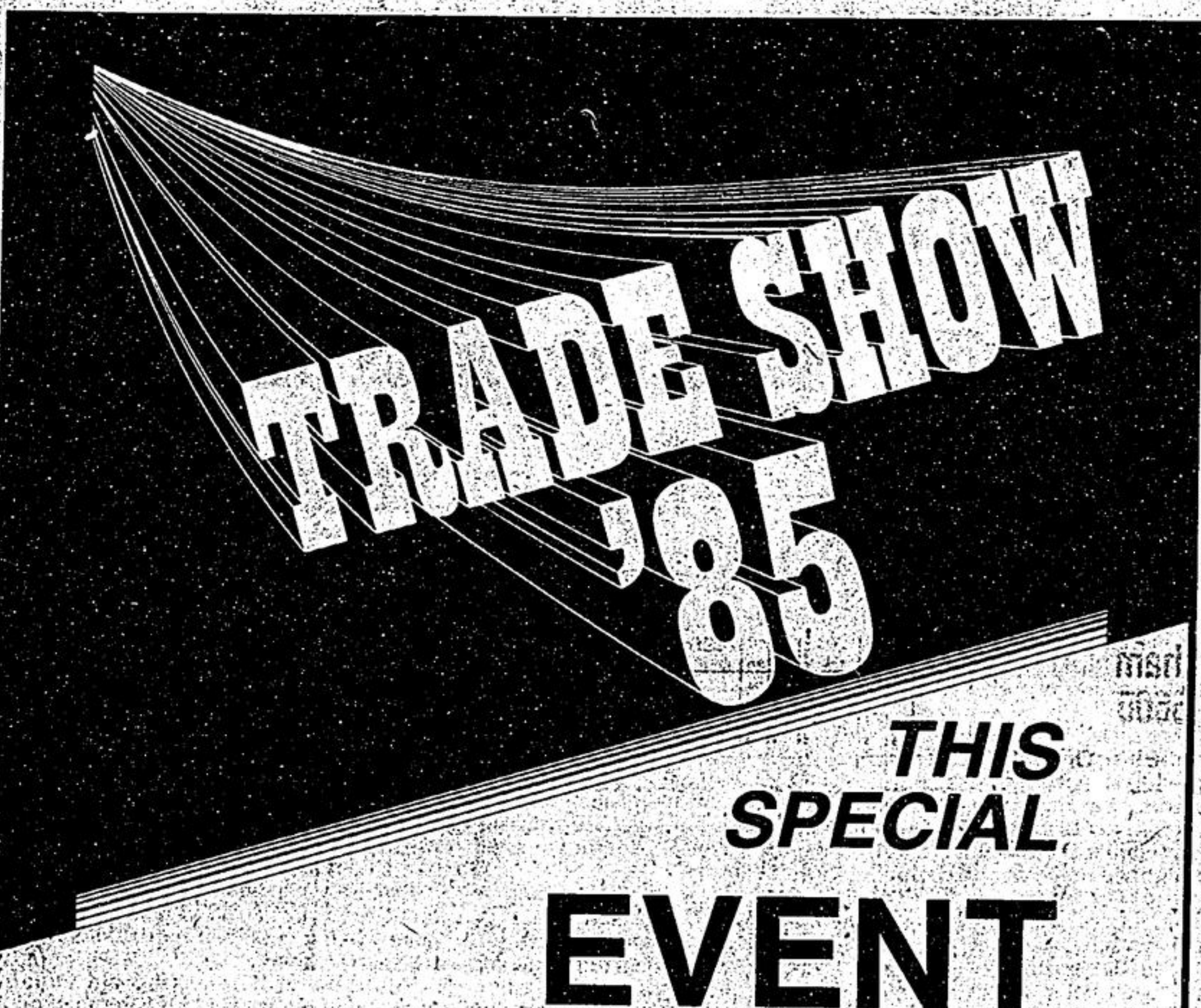


Shaunna honored for boy's rescue

The Stouffville girl, employed as a summer instructor with the Township's swimming program, used life-saving techniques to revive a drowning six-year-old boy at Sibbald's Point Provincial Park, July 10. 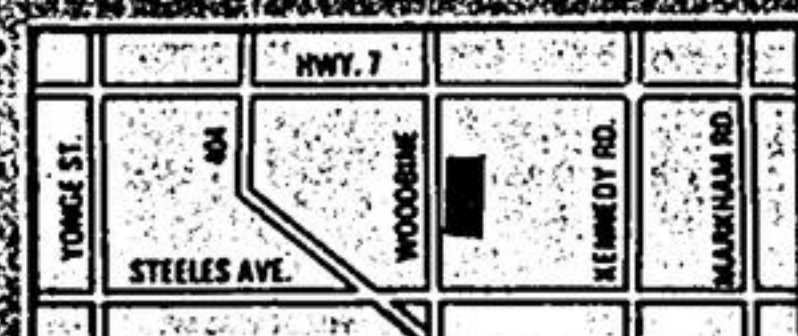
