Unionville athlete wins Masters bronze

A truly international field made up the medal-winners of the recent Masters Games 400-m. run. But no one was more surprised than Unionville's Shirley Vedder when she found herself among them.
 "I was amazed, because I knew I was in tough competition from the qualifier," said the Liebeck Cres. resident after placing third in the 40 to 44-year-old division.
 A Singapore runner took top spot, with a Texan coming in second.
 Vedder was pleased with her finish because her time of 64 seconds shaved four seconds off her personal best time.
 "I extended myself due to the fast pace," she said, explaining her time. "In order to stay in I knew I had to come up with a good performance. But I was happy just to qualify for the final."
 A healthy dose of fast-paced racket sports is what Vedder attributes for her strong performance. She only started training specifically for track last winter with her twin 13-year-old children Jamie and Julie.
 She also competed in the 100 and 200-m. distances, finishing fifth in both and shav-

ing about a second off her personal bests in each event.
 "I found style and form is important in the shorter distances because the races are so quick," Vedder explained. "In the 400-m. run, stamina and strength are needed."
