## Husband wife join staff

STOUFFVILLE — A husband and wife team has joined the staff of the Stouffville Christian School.

Ken and Carolyn Benson, both graduates of Queen's University, Kingston, are presently residing at Gormley but will move to Stouffville after Christmas.

Ken will be teaching at the Grade 8 level. Carolyn will take charge of a Special Education class.

Principal Wally Robinson is highly complimentary of both Ken and Carolyn saying they will be valuable additions to the school's staff that now totals 12 full-time and four part-time teachers.

Ken is a graduate of Stouffville Dist. Secondary School, receiving his honors graduation diploma in 1979. He was the class valedictorian at Commencement Exercises that fall. A highly competitive athlete, he excelled in volleyball, basketball, softball, track and field, soccer and rugby.

In the years that have followed, Ken has continued this interest in athletics serving as a coach of both men's and women's volleyball teams.

From 1980 to 1983, Ken served as president of the Inter-Varsity Christian Fellowship at Laurentian University. He also assisted as a Sunday School teacher at the Gormley Missionary Church.

Following graduation from S.D.S.S., Ken attended Ontario Bible College in Toronto, then enrolled at Laurentian University, Sudbury, graduating with an Honors Bachelor of Physical and Health Education degree in 1983. He was named to the university's Dean's Honor List from 1981 to 1983.

Ken obtained his Ontario Teacher's Certificate and his Bachelor of Education degree from Queen's in May, 1984. In August of this year, he received his M.A. degree in Health Education from the University of Western Ontario, London, Ont.

Carolyn is an honors graduate from Earl of March Secondary School, Kanata, Ontario. In 1978-79, she was the Student Council's Head Girl and Student of the Year.

In 1982, Carolyn attended the Institute of Ministry at Bradenton, Florida, later enrolling at Waterloo University where she obtained her Bachelor of Arts degree in Honors Co-op Recreation in 1983. Carolyn received her Bachelor of Education degree and her Ontario Teacher's Certificate from Queen's University in 1984.

Carolyn's teacher-related experiences are extensive, ranging from a CGIT director at Camp Kalalla to community recreation planner for the Toronto Parks & Recreation Commission.

In 1979-80, she served as a volunteer in a Kitchener-Waterloo Junior Sports Program for physically disabled children and a Pre-School Program Instructor with the Ottawa YMCA and YWCA in 1981.

She was co-ordinator of the Inter-Varsity Christian Fellowship at Queen's University Faculty of Education in 1983-84.

Like husband Ken, Carolyn is an excellent athlete, excelling in gymnastics, cross-country, track and field, soccer and skiing. She's been the recipient of three aquatic awards as well as certificates in St. John Ambulance Emergency First Aid, Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation and Fitness Instruction.

## Plan tent meetings

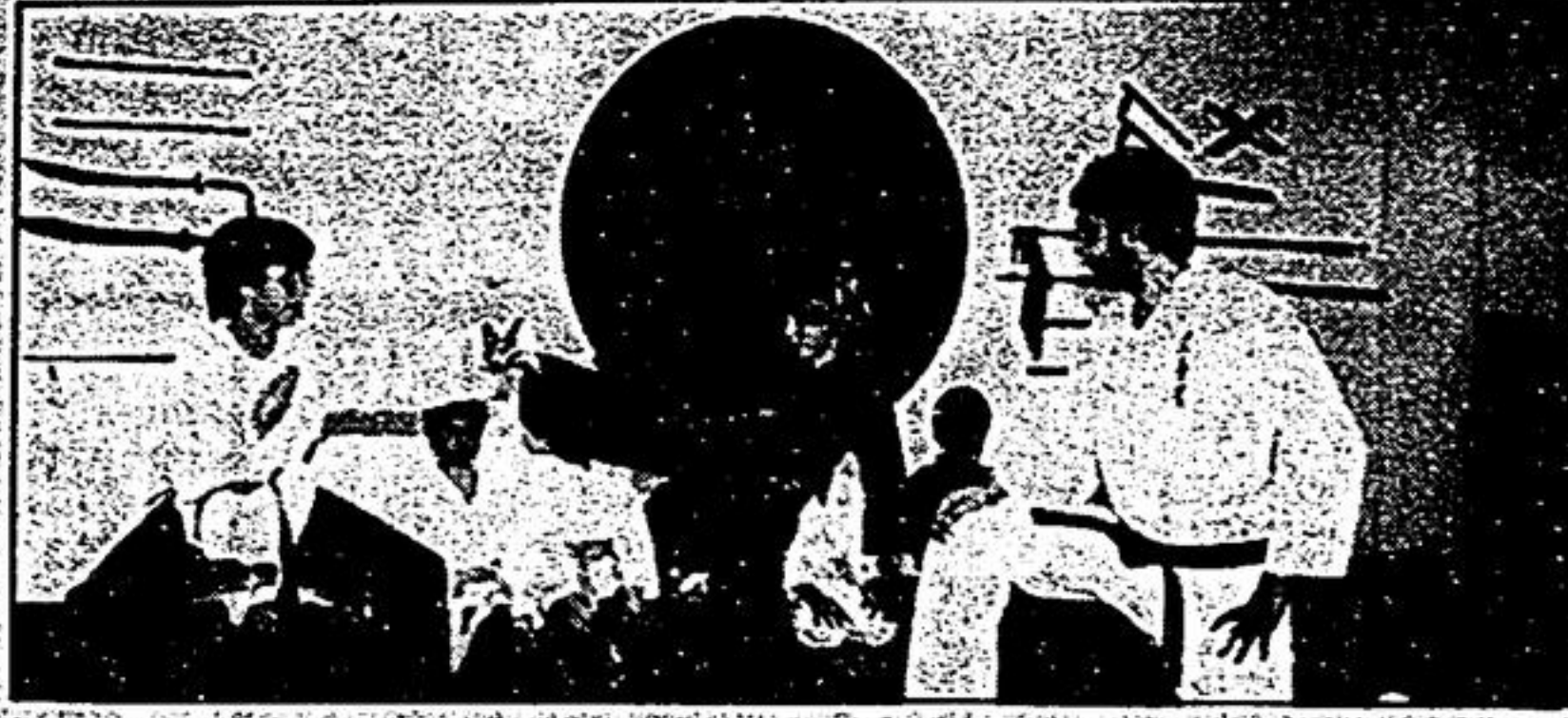
STOUFFVILLE — Tent meetings, once popular here, will return for the weekend of Sept. 13 to 15.

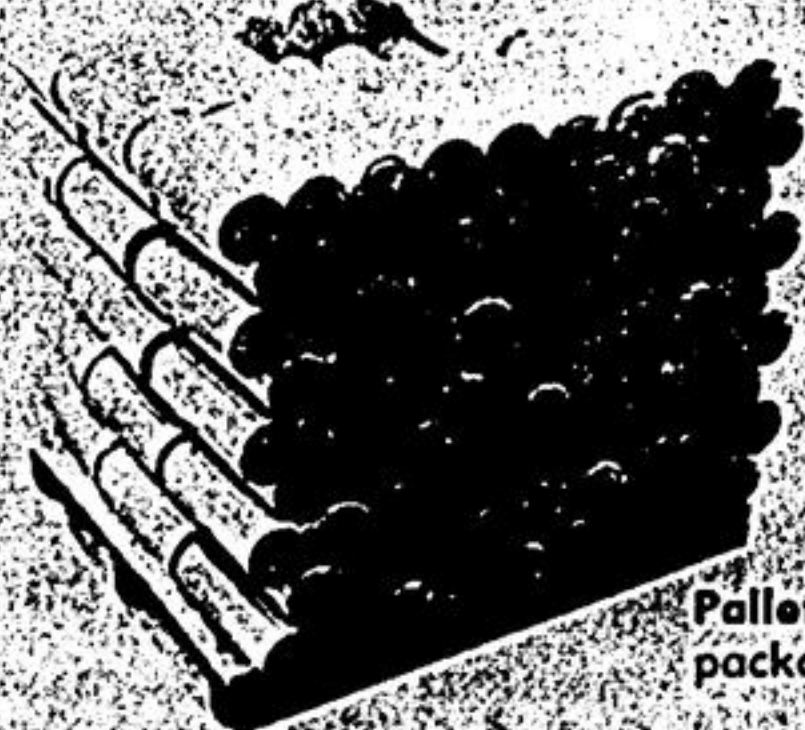

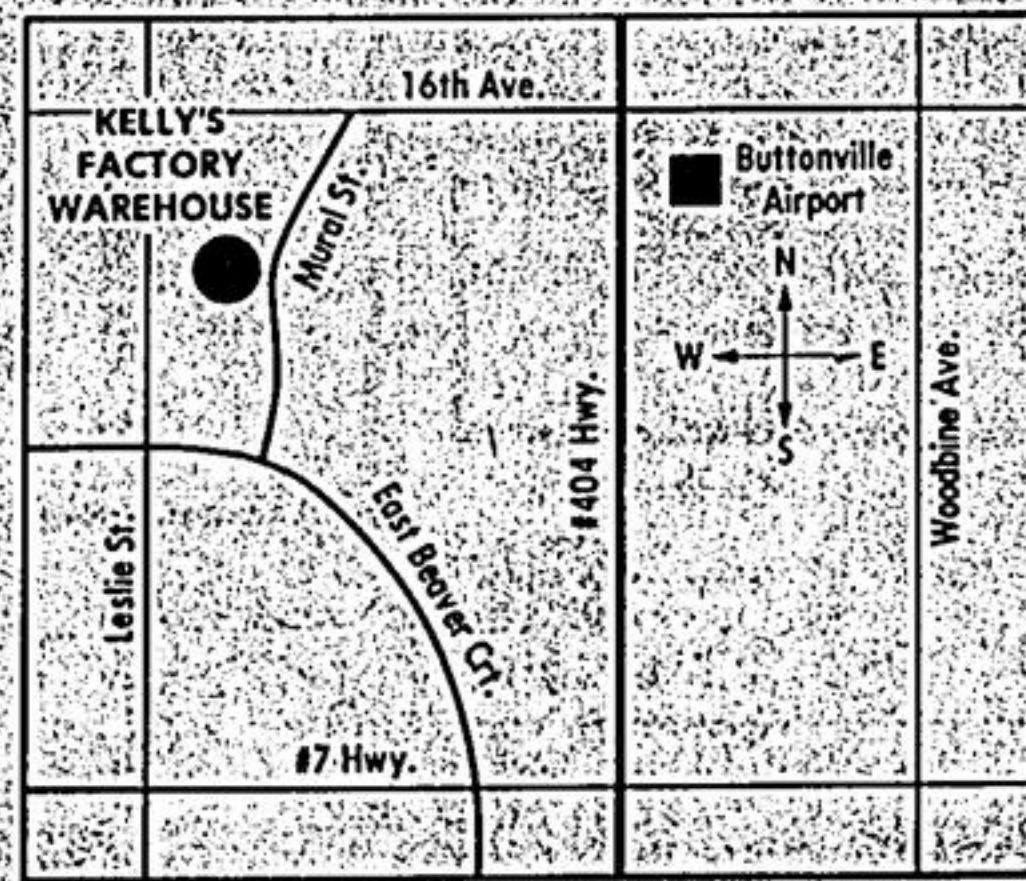
