## Phee elected national head of Kinsmen

A Markham businessman was elected the 65th national president of the Kinsmen, an association that donated over \$23-million to Canadian communities in the past year.

Howard Phee, international vice-president of finance and corporate services for Markham's Geac Computers was elected to the post at the Kinsmen's annual convention in Toronto last month.

Mr. Phee is a member of the Kinsmen Club of Bolton, Ont. and has been a Kinsman for nine years. He has also held many club offices including president.

He and wife Carol are both involved with the Kinsmen with Mrs. Phee being the Association's national Kinette coordinator.

This year the national Association was again the largest single contributor to the Canadian Cystic Fibrosis Foundation. Kinsmen and Kinettes donated a record \$1.1 million to help find a cure. In addition, various Association members support other organizations including the Canadian Diabetes Association, the Multiple Sclerosis Society and the March of Dimes.

The Association of Kinsmen Clubs is an all-Canadian organization founded in Hamilton in 1920. It has a membership of nearly 20,000 men and women in 1,100 clubs across the country.

Value of the stolen goods is unknown. Damage is estimated at \$50.

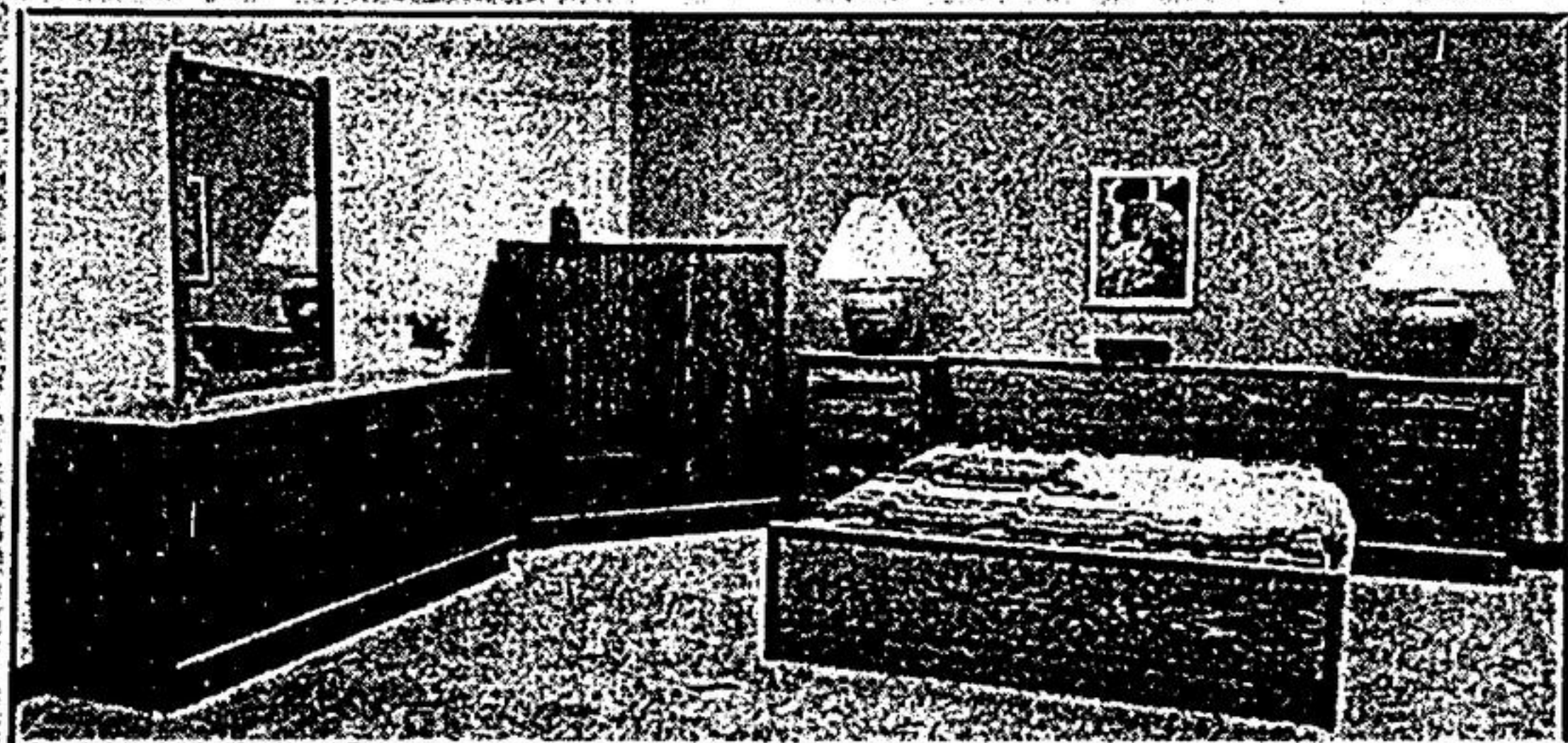

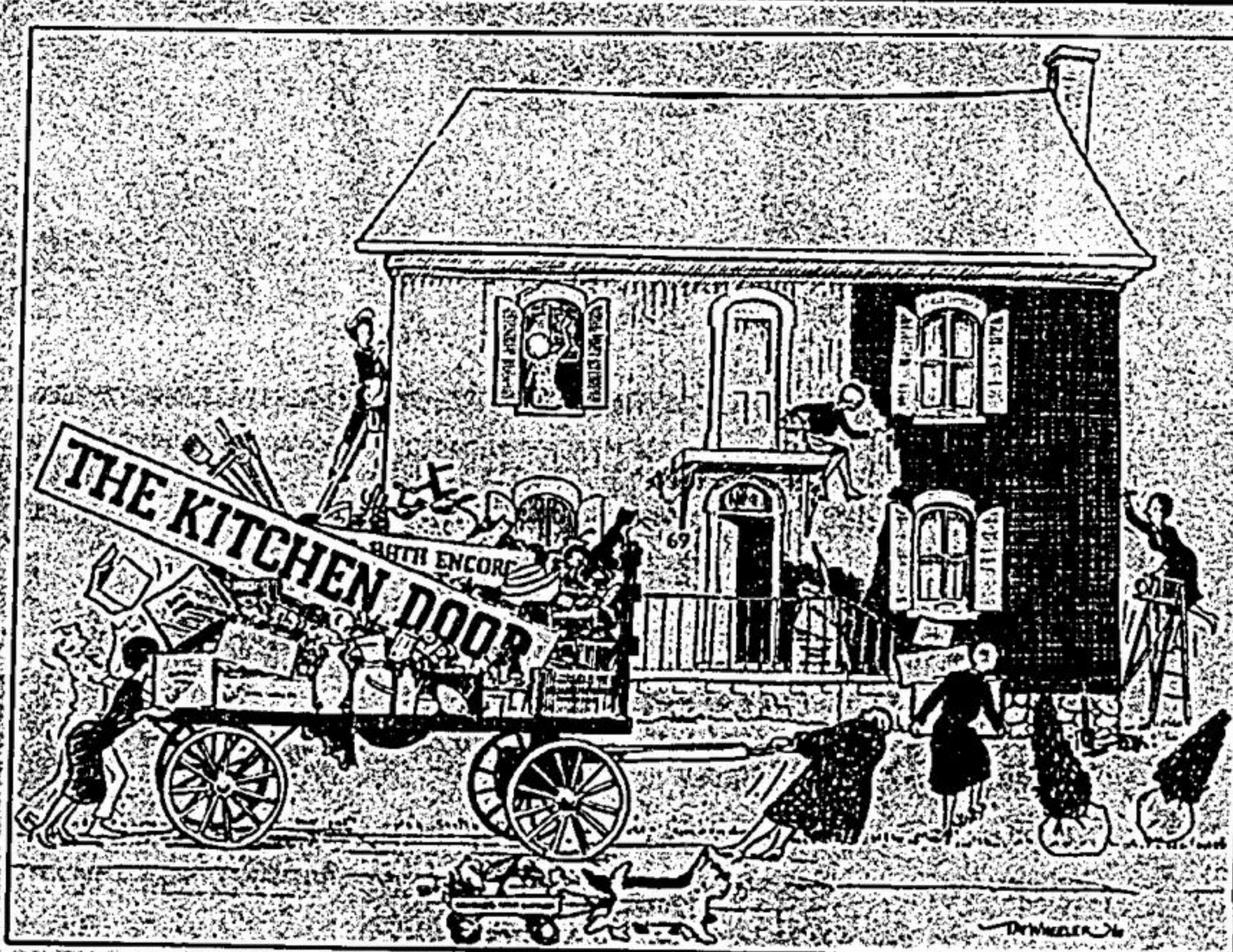
