Jopp still on safety patrol

At the age of 81, Sebert Jopp's still on patrol at Uxbridge Public School.

Following six years as a school crossing guard in Pickering, the likeable senior citizen is continuing his career as an assistant with Uxbridge's student safety patrol.

"I had my eye on the kids because it had been my job for six years," he says of his first visit to the Victoria Ave. school early one September morning.

Mr. Jopp, who moved to Uxbridge in August, admits he initially drew some suspicious looks from parents and concerned school officials whom he says were probably wondering "who the strange man was."

But a brief chat convinced vice principal Wendell Fisher of the newcomer's integrity and of his good intentions.

"We're quite glad to have him," says Mr. Fisher, who was instrumental in creating the volunteer position. "He acts as a mentor for the children. They enjoy him and he certainly likes them."

To show its appreciation, the school supplied the octogenarian with an official patroller's badge and a raincoat for protection against inclement weather.

Mr. Jopp says he "loves Uxbridge" even though it is a lot colder than his native Kingston, Jamaica, where he worked as a cook before his emigration in the late 1970s.


Prior to entering the Brookside Apartments, he lived with his daughter Olive Pickering and family in, you guessed it, Pickering.

He was formally introduced to all the school's classes and is now on a first-name basis with many Uxbridge students.

The volunteer is impressed with the knowledge and maturity displayed by the 65-strong safety unit, but doesn't hesitate to share with the pupils his "knowledge of all the rules and regulations."

Mr. Jopp said he would still consider an offer to serve as a full-time crossing guard for the municipality of Uxbridge.

He served in that capacity while working for the Town of Pickering at both Sir John A. Macdonald and Holy Redeemer schools.
