

Arthurs seeks re-election in Pickering

Pickering's Ward 3 local councillor Wayne Arthurs has decided to seek re-election rather than move up and enter the mayoralty race.

Councillor Arthurs considered challenging incumbent mayor Jack Anderson, but the results of a recent poll convinced him he was needed in his home ward.

The Nov. 12 mayoralty race has three candidates: Mayor Anderson, Ward 1 regional councillor Laurie Cahill and ex-separate school board chairman Larry O'Leary. A fourth person, Heinz Raedisch, pulled out of the contest late Tuesday.

Mr. Arthurs' only opponent for his north Pickering seat is Ralph Bradley.

WARD 3 REGION

Ward 3's regional incumbent Norah Stoner of Greenwood is being challenged by one opponent, Brougham's Rick Johnson.

TRUSTEE

There's a three-way race for Pickering's Ward 3 public school trustee seat on Durham Region Board of Education. Seven-year veteran Linda Carder of Claremont is being opposed by fellow Claremont resident Lyn Craig and Locust Hill's Keith Pymar. Mrs. Carder was acclaimed in 1982.
